Classico (Gründl)
50 % virgin wool (Merino super-wash), 50 % acrylic
50 g / 120 m

Size:

48/50 (52/54)

Consumption:

approx. 350 (400) g colour 18 (tanne)
and approx. 350 (400) g colour 11
(bordeaux)

Pattern:

Relief pattern: (number of st. divisible by 2 + 1 st + 2 edge stitches)

1. r (= return row): 1 edge stitch, knit 1 st. purl and 1 st. plain alternately, end with 1 st. purl, 1 edge stitch

2. r (= right-side-row): knit all st. plain between edge stitches.

keep repeating rows 1.-2.

Emphasised decreases at right edge in relief pattern:

The emphasised decreases are worked in the right-side-rows: 1 edge stitch, 2 st. plain, 1 st. lifted over (= lift off 1 st as if knitting plain, 1 st. plain, then pull over lifted st.)

Emphasised decreases at left edge in relief pattern:

The emphasised decrease are worked in the right-side-rows: knit up to 5 st. before end of row according to pattern, knit 2 st. together, 2 st. plain, 1 edge stitch

In return rows, knit lifted over and 2 st. knitted together in plain as purl, continue remaining st. in pattern.

Knotted edge stitch:

Lift off in plain at beginning of row, knit plain at end of row.

Cuff pattern (number of st. divisible by 2):

Front and back row: knit alternately 1 st. plain and 1 st. purl between edge stitches.

Colour sequence:

7 r colour 18, * 2 r colour 11, 2 r colour 18, 8 r colour 11, 2 r colour 18, 2 r colour 11, 8 r colour 18, keep repeating from *

Stitch test: (relief pattern)

26 st. x 34 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Instructions:

Pullover: (deviating information for larger sizes are in brackets)

Back:

Cast on 125 (135) st. plus 2 edge stitches in colour tanne, start with 1 return row and knit in relief

pattern in specified colour sequence. In the process, for side shaping add 1 st. 6 x in every 22. r on both sides, by adding 1 st plain twisted from the cross thread at the beginning of the row after the edge stitch (= 139 (149) st.). Insert the added stitches into the relief pattern. At a total height of 42 (44) cm (= 143 (151) r) decrease on both sides respectively 1 st. emphasised 11 (12) x in every 2. r at right and left edge for the shaping of the sleeve recess. (= 117 (125) st.). At a total height of 61 (64) cm (= 207 (219) r) cast off 3 x in each 2. r on both sides respectively 11 (12) st. for shoulder shaping. Cast off remaining 51 (53) st. straight.

Front:

Work as back, but cast off the centre 23 (25) st. for neck at the height of 57 (60) cm (= 193 (204) r), then finish side separately. For internal round, cast off another 1 x 5 st, 1 x 3 st, 1 x 2 st and 4 x 1 st in every 2. row. At the same time, work shoulder shape as in back. Finish 2. side in mirror image.

Sleeves:

Cast on 57 (63) st plus 2 edge stitches in colour tanne, start with 1 return row and knit in relief pattern in specified colour sequence. To shape the sleeve, add on both sides 24 x 1 st. in each 6. row (= 107 (113) st.). At a total height of 50 (52) cm (= 169 (177) r) cast off for sleeve head on both sides 3 x 2 st, 3 x 3 st, 3 x 4 st and 3 x 6 st in every 2. row, cast off remaining 17 (23) st straight. Work 2. sleeve identically.

Completion:

Close one shoulder seam flat. For the neck edge, take up approx. 120 (126) st. in colour tanne from neck edge and knit 2.5 cm (= 9 rows) in cuff pattern, then cast off st. straight, hereby knitting st. as they appear. Close the 2. shoulder seam with the narrow side of the neck panel. Insert sleeves and close side and sleeve seams.

Abbreviations:

st = stitch(es)
r = row(s) = cast on
cast off = cast off

Pattern design (cm):
