

## Pattern

CLASSICO

## Men's cap and loop

Difficulty level:


Quality:
Classico (Gründl)
50 \% virgin wool (Merino superwash), 50 \% acrylic
$50 \mathrm{~g} / 120 \mathrm{~m}$
$7(8) \times \quad 7(8) \times$

## Size:

Loop: Height approx. 19 cm,
circumference approx. 136 cm
Cap: Head circumference
approx. $57 \mathrm{~cm}-60 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Consumption:

Loop: approx. 200 g colour 11 (bordeaux) and approx. 100 g colour 18 (tanne)
Cap: approx. 100 g colour 18 (tanne)

## Pattern:

Loop: Rib pattern in front and return rows Number of st. divisible by 4 plus 2 edge stitches): Front and back row: knit alternately 2 st. plain and 2 st. purl between edge stitches.
Chain edge stitches:
Knit twisted plain at beginning of row, lift off stitch at end of row, placing the yarn in front of the st.
Cap: Rib pattern in rounds (number of st. divisible by 4)
knit 2 st. plain and 2 st. purl alternately
Stitch test: (rib pattern, do not measure while stretched)
Loop: 40 st $\times 28 \mathrm{r}=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
Cap: 40 st $\times 30 \mathrm{r}=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Instructions:

Loop: Cast on 76 st plus 2 edge stitches in colour bordeaux and initially knit 68 cm in colour bordeaux, then knit 68 cm alternately 2 r in colour tanne and $2 r$ in colour bordeaux in rib pattern. At 136 total height cast off stitches straight, in the process, knit stitches as they come. Sew cast on and cast off edge of the loop together.

## Cap:

Cast on 128 st in colour tanne, spread onto
4 needles of the set ( $=32$ st per needle) and knit 24 cm (= 72 rd.) in rib pattern. Then cast off as follows, hereby always knitting the remaining st up to rd. 83 as they come
73. row: purl together the two purl st in every 2. left rib (=112 st)
74.-76. row: knit without decreasing
77. row: purl the two purl st. together in the emaining left ribs (= 96 st.)
78.-79. row: knit without decreasing
80. row: knit together the two plain st. in each 2. plain rib (=80 st)
81. row: knit without decreasing
82. row: knit together the two plain st. in each plain rib (= 64 st)
83. row: knit without decreasing

Now finish the cap in stocking stitch
84. row: knit together each 3. + 4. row (= 48 st )
85. row: knit without decreasing
86. row: knit together each 2 st. (= 24 st )
87. row: knit without decreasing
88. Round: knit each 2 st together in plain
(= 12 st )
Pull remaining st together with working yarn.

## Abbreviations: <br> st. = stitch(es)

$r=\operatorname{row}(\mathrm{s})$
