Cuddly Socks

Difficulty:



Needles:



5 – 6 mm

Quality:

Koala from Gründl
100 % Polyester
100 g / 100 m

Size:

shown here size M (EU shoe size
36 – 38)
Refer to size chart „Koala Cuddly
Socks“ for sizes S (33 – 35) and L
(39 – 41)

Usage:

Size S: approx. 100 g,
size M and up: approx. 200 g

Stitch Pattern:

Ribbing in rnds.: (amount of sts multiple of 2)

alt k1, p1

Stockinette Stitch:

in rnds.: knit.

in RS and WS rows.: RS rows: knit, WS rows:purl

Tension:

14 sts and 20 rows/rnds to 10 cm meas over
stockinette stitch

Instructions: (for additional sizes refer to size
chart „Koala Cuddly Socks“)

Cast on 28 sts and divide evenly amongst
4 dpns (7 sts per needle) and close rnd being ca-
reful not to twist the sts. Work 15 cm (= 30 rnds)
in ribbing for the shaft (for size S approx. 13 cm
(= 26 rnds), for size L approx. 17 cm (= 34 rnds)).
Then work the heel with short rows in stockinet-
te st over the sts on the first and fourth needles
(see size chart). Move the sts onto one needle
for the foll rows:

Row 1: knit, turn work

Row 2: Work the first st as a double st: wyif
insert needle from the right side into the
stitch, then sl the st with the yarn, then
bring yarn to the back of the work over
the top of the needle and pull tightly so
that both legs of the stitch in the row
below are on the needle. Then purl rest
of row. Turn work.

Row 3: Work the first st as a double st, knit rem
sts to the double st then turn work. (the
double sts remain unworked).

Row 4: Work first st as a double st, purl to the
double st then turn work.

Rep rows 3 and 4 until the first and last st of the
centre third of the heel sts are worked as double
sts (refer to size chart: each side 5 double sts, in
the middle 4 sts)

Now work 2 rnds over all sts on all 4 needles,
working the loops of the double sts together as
one st. In the 2nd rnd work to the end of the 3rd

needle. Then cont again in rows over the first and 4th needle (14 sts).

Row 1: Knit the sts on the side third (refer to chart: 5 sts) and the sts in the centre third of the heel sts (refer to chart: 4 sts). Turn work.

Row 2: Work the first st as a double st, purl the rem sts up to and including the last st of the centre third. Turn work.

Row 3: Work the first st as a double st, then knit all sts up to the double st. Then knit the two loops of the double st together. Then knit the foll sts on the side third. Turn work.

Row 4: Work the first st as a double st, then purl the sts up to the double st. Then purl the two loops of the double st together. Then purl the foll sts on the side third. Turn work.

Rep rows 3 and 4 until all sts on the side third are worked. Then cont again in rnds until the beg of the toe.

When foot length meas 22 cm (meas from the centre of the heel, refer to chart) work the flat toe in stockinette st. To do so, k2tog on the first and 3rd needle every 2nd and third last st together and skp the 2nd and 3rd sts on each of the 2nd and 4th needles. Knit the rem sts. Work the decs as given in chart. Then cut yarn with tail, thread through rem sts and pull tightly to close hole. Weave in ends.
