

# Pattern

## COTTON FUN

### Top with Net Lace Pattern

#### Difficulty Level:



#### Needles:



3,0 - 4,0

#### Quality:

Cotton Fun from Gründl  
100 % Cotton  
50 g / 115 m



6 (7 - 8) x

#### Size:

Women's EU size 36/38 [40/42 - 44/46]

#### Usage:

approx. 300 [350 - 400] g in col. 01 (white)

#### Pattern:

Lace patt: (amount of sts multiple of 2)  
*RS and WS rows:* \* yo, p2tog, rep from \*  
Stockinette st: RS rows k all sts; WS rows p all sts.

Selvedge sts: Slip first st k-wise and p last st of row.

#### Tension:

15 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm meas over lace patt using size 3,5mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

22 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm meas over stockinette st using size 3,5mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

**Instructions:** (changes for the larger sizes are given in brackets. If only one number is shown, this applies to all 3 sizes)

Front and Back are worked from side to side.

#### Back:

Cast on 114 [118 - 121] sts (incl. selvedge sts) and work as foll:

Row 1: (= WS row) 1 selvedge st, k21 [21 - 23], p73 [75 - 76], k18 [20 - 20], selvedge st.

Row 2: 1 selvedge st, k112 [116 - 119], 1 selvedge st.  
Row 3: 1 selvedge st, k1, 20 [20 - 22] sts in lace patt, p89 [93 - 94] sts, k2, selvedge st.

Row 4: 1 selvedge st, k91 [95 - 96], 20 [20 - 22] sts in lace patt, k1, 1 selvedge st.

Rows 3- 4 establish patt. Rep these two rows throughout.

When work meas total of 49 [54 - 59] cm (= 157 [173 - 189] rows) work the next two rows as the 2nd and then the first row. Next row: cast off all sts k-wise.

#### Front:

Work as for back, only 3 [4 - 4] cm shorter.

Cast on 107 [109 - 112] sts (incl. selvedge sts) and work as foll:

Row 1: (= WS row) 1 selvedge st, k21 [21 - 23], p73 [75 - 76], k11, selvedge st.

Row 2: 1 selvedge st, k105 [107 - 110], 1 selvedge st.

Row 3: 1 selvedge st, k1, 20 [20 - 22] sts in lace patt, p82 [84 - 85] sts, k2, selvedge st.

Row 4: 1 selvedge st, k84 [86 - 87], 20 [20 - 22] sts in lace patt, k1, 1 selvedge st.

Rows 3- 4 establish patt. Rep these two rows throughout.

When work meas total of 49 [54 - 59] cm (= 157 [173 - 189] rows) work the next two rows as the 2nd and then the first row. Next row: cast off all sts k-wise.

Finishing:

Block front and back according to schematics. Place a moist towel over knitted pieces and allow to dry. Close shoulder seams leaving the centre 26 [28 - 30] cm open for the neck opening. Close side seams leaving 18 [19 - 21] cm open for the arm openings and for the slit 5 cm on the front piece and 8 [9 - 9] cm on the back (see schematic as reference). Weave in ends.
