Wash Mitt

Needles:

Flipsy (Gründl)
100 % Polyester
100 g / 50 m

Size:

Circumference: approx. 22 cm,
height: approx. 20 cm

Usage:

approx. 100 g each in
col. 02 (light grey) or col.
03 (mint) or Fb. 04 (lilac)

Stitch Pattern:

Stockinette Stitch: *in rounds:* k all sts in all rnds.

Tension:

(glatt rechts)
11 sts and 16 rounds to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch using size 6 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

Instructions:

Cast on 24 sts and divide sts evenly amongst 4 dpns (= 6 sts on each needle) and close the round being careful not to twist the sts. Work 20 cm even in stockinette st pattern. Then move the sts to 2 needles (12 sts per needle) and cast off together as follows: lay both needles parallel, insert a 3rd needle into the 1st st of each needle and knit these 2 sts together, * then the next sts of the 1st and 2nd needle k2tog. The righthand needle now has 2 sts on it. Slip the 1st st on the 3rd needle over the 2nd st and off the needle. Repeat from * across the row until all sts are cast off.

Push the fringe to the WS of the work and turn mitt so the purl sts are on the outside.

Hanger: ch 20 sts and sew onto mitt.

approx. = approximate(ly)

ch = chain

dpn(s) = double pointed needles

k = knit

rep = repeat

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

tbl = through back loop

tog = together

WS = wrong side
