

# Pattern

## PASTELLO

### Brioche Pattern Scarf

#### Difficulty level:



#### Needles:



5 - 6

#### Quality:

Pastello from Gründl  
58 % Cotton,  
42 % Polyacrylic  
200 g / 400 m

#### Size:

Width: approx. 34 cm,  
Length: approx. 200 cm

Usage: approx. 500 g in col.  
02 (mauve-pearl pastel ombre  
color)

#### Needles:

1 pair of circular needles in size 5,0 - 6,0 mm or size needed to achieve given tension.

#### Tension:

15 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm measured over brioche stitch pattern using size 5 - 6mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

#### Stitch Pattern:

Brioche Pattern with Double Selvedge Stitches: (amount of sts multiple of 2 + 1 + 4 selvedge sts)  
*Row 1 (= WS row):* 2 selvedge sts, \* k1, sl1 p-wise with yo, rep from \* to last 3 sts, then k1, 2 selvedge sts.

*Row 2 (= RS row):* 2 selvedge sts, \* sl1 p-wise with yo, k2tog (sl st and yo of previous row), rep from \* to last 3 sts, then sl1 p-wise with yo, 2 selvedge sts.

*Row 3:* 2 selvedge sts, \* k2tog (sl st and yo of previous row), sl1 p-wise with yo, rep from \* and end row with k2tog (sl st and yo of previous row) and 2 selvedge sts.

These rows establish the pattern. Rep rows 2 and 3 cont throughout.

#### Double Selvedge Stitch (2 selvedge sts):

Work the first two and last two sts in each RS row: k2 and in the WS rows: sl 2 p-wise wyif.

#### Instructions:

Cast on 55 sts (incl. 4 selvedge sts) and beg. with a WS row work in brioche pattern with double selvedge sts on each edge. Work straight for total of 200 cm ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): cast off all sts even, k the selvedge sts, work the sl st and yo of previous row as k2tog and p the sts in between.
