## Scarf and Hat

## Needles:

Quality:
Mohana from Gründl
90 \% Polyacrylic, 10 \% Mohair $100 \mathrm{~g} / 215 \mathrm{~m}$


Size:
Scarf: width: approx. 28 cm , length: approx. 200 cm Hat: head circumference approx. 52-56 cm

Scarf and Hat: approx. 400 g in col. 05 (rose-grey-taupe)

## Brioche Pattern

(amount of sts multiple of $4+1+2$ selvedge sts Row 1 (= WS row): selvedge st, * sll p-wise with yo, k1, pl, k1, rep from * to end of row then sll p -wise with yo, selvedge st
Row 2 (= RS row): selvedge st, * p2tog (sl st and yo of previous row), k1, sl1 p-wise with yo, k1, rep from * to end of row then sll p-wise with yo selvedge st
Row 3: selvedge st, * sll p-wise with yo, k1, p2tog sl st and yo of previous row), kl, rep from * to end of row then sll p-wise with yo, selvedge st
These rows establish the pattern. Rep rows 2-3 cont throughout.
Selvedge Stitch: kltbl at beg of row and sl 1 wyif at end of each row
Hat:
Ribbing in rnds: (amount of sts multiple of 2) Alt kl, pl cont throughout
Stockinette Stitch in rnds: k all sts in all rnds

## Tension:

Scarf: 18 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over brioche stitch pattern using size 5-6 mm or size needed to achieve given tension. Hat: 19 sts and 24 rnds to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch using size 5-6 mm needles.

## Instructions:

Scarf:
Cast on 51 sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and work 200 cm in brioche pattern beginning and ending with a WS row. Next row: cast off all sts k-wise. Weave in ends.

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Using the smaller dpns cast on 96 sts an divi de the sts evenly amongst the needles (= $4 \times$ 24 sts). Close ring being careful not to twist the sts. Work 4 cm ( $=11 \mathrm{rnds}$ ) in ribbing pattern. Then change to larger needles ( $5-6 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) and work in stockinette st. When work meas. $19 \mathrm{~cm}(=48$ rnds) place markers at every 8th st. Next rnd: * k to 1 st before marker, k2tog (next
st and st with marker). Rep from * to end of
rnd. Then work these decs every 2 nd rnd 6
times more. Cut yarn and pull through last 12
sts twice and pull yarn taught to close the gap
and avoid a hole. Weave in ends.
