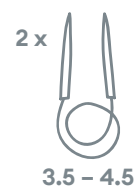
Pullover, cap, shoes in relief pattern

Pattern:

garter stitch:

Knit rows to and fro in plain st.

Relief pattern:

see knitting chart, only rows facing front are indicated, in the return rows, knit stitches as they appear

Always repeat 1.–16. rows.

Edge stitch:

at the start of a row slip stitch as in knit, at the end of the row knit plain stitch

Stitch test (relief pattern):

24 st. x 34 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Instructions:

Pullover: (deviating information for larger sizes are in brackets)

Back:

Cast on 65 (73) st. plus 2 edge stitches and knit garter stitch between edge stitches for 7 rows, starting with a return row. Subsequently, knit relief pattern between edge stitches: After edge stitch, knit the rapport in the width 8 (9) x and end with 1 edge stitch after the rapport. Attention! For sizes 68/74, do not start with the 1. pattern row, but initially knit the 9.–16. row of the knitting chart. Subsequently, keep repeating the 1.–16. rows. At a total height of 15.5 (17.5) cm (= 55 (63) row) for the raglan angle, cast off as follows: 1 edge stitch, knit 2 st. slipped over in plain (= lift 1 st. off in plain, 1 st. plain, slip lifted st. over), knit up to 3 st. before the end of the row, knit 2 st. together in plain, 1 edge stitch. Repeat these cast-offs in each 2. row for another 19 (23) x (= 27 st.). Cast off these 27 stitches straight in the following front-facing row.

Front:

Work like back, but—at a total height of 18 (20) cm (= 63 (71) row) knit in the following front-facing row for the slit as follows: 1 edge stitch, 2 st. knitted together slipped over in plain, the following 23 (27) st. knitted as per pattern, 2 st. garter stitch, add 1 st. twisted from

the cross thread, 1 edge stitch (= 30 (34) st.). Immobilise the remaining 30 (34) st. and initially finish the left front, hereby working the raglan angle as in back and knitting the last 3 st. before the edge stitch in garter stitch (= slit panel). Cast off the remaining 14 st. straight in the same height as the back.

Subsequently, finishing the immobilised 30 (34) for the right half in the mirror image, however without addition in the 1. row.

Sleeves (2 x):

Cast on 33 st. plus 2 edge stitches and knit garter stitch between edge stitches for 7 rows, beginning with a return row.

Then continue in relief pattern (knit the rapport 4 x after the edge stitch, finish with 1 st. after the rapport and 1 edge stitch). Attention! For sizes 56/62, do not start with the 1. pattern row, but initially knit the 9.-16. row of the knitting chart. Subsequently, keep repeating the 1.-16. rows. At the same time, increase for the sleeve angle on both sides alternatively in each 4. and 6. row 8 x 1 st. (in each 4. row 12 x 1 st.). (= at the beginning of the row after the edge stitch and at the end before the edge stitch, add 1 st. according to pattern in plain and/or purl twisted from the cross thread) (= 51 (59) st.). Insert the added stitches into the relief pattern. At a total height of 13.5 (15.5) cm (= 47 (55) row) work the raglan angle as in the back (= 11 st.). Cast off these 11 st. straight.

Cord (x 2):

finished length: approx. 25 cm for the cords, cut 2 threads à approx. 1 m, fold them in half, affix the end to e.g. a door handle and twist a cord. Twist until the cord twists together as soon as the tension is slightly released. Now fold the twisted cord once more into half, smooth it out and secure with a knot on both ends.

Finish:

Connect the front and back part with the sleeves at the raglan angle. Close the side and sleeve seams.

For the neck panel, take up approx. 63 st. and knit in garter stitch for 7 rows. Cast off the stitches in the next row.

Sew the cords to the left and right of the neck panel.

Cap: (Information for larger sizes in brackets) The cap is knitted open in rows to and fro.

Cast on 81 (89) st. plus 2 edge stitches and knit 7 rows in garter stitch between the edge stitches, beginning with a return row. Sub-

sequently, continue knitting in relief pattern between edge stitches, hereby adding 8 st. evenly spread in the 1. row. Knit (= 91 (99) M) and the rapport 11 (12) x, end with the st. after the rapport. At a total height of 11 (13) cm (= 39 (47) row) finish the cap in stocking stitch and decrease between the edge stitches as follows: each 8 st. (alternating each 9. and 10. st. and knit this stitch together in plain with the stitch before (= 80 (89) st.). Repeat this cast off in every 2. row until only 14 (19) st. remain. Pull these stitches together with the working yarn. Tip: pull the thread through the stitch several times so no hole remains.

Close the rear seam as flat as possible.

Shoes: (information for larger sizes in brackets)

Cast on 32 (36) st. plus 2 edge stitches and knit 7 rows in garter stitch between the edge stitches, beginning with the return row Subsequently knit stocking stitch over all stitches between edge stitches.

At a total height of 6 (7) cm (= 21 (25) row), knit one row as follows for the cord insert: 1 edge st., 1 st. plain, * 1 slip stitch, knit 2 st. together in plain, repeat from *, end with 1 st. plain, 1 edge st. Subsequently knit one more return row in purl, also knit the slip stitches in purl.

Now, for the top of the shoe continue with garter stitch over the centre 10 (12) st., immobilise 12 (13) st. on both sides. After approx. 4 (5) cm (= 20 (24) rows) garter stitch, also immobilise these stitches.

Now, for the sides of the shoes, initially knit the immobilised 12 (13) of the right side in plain, then with the working thread take up 10 (12) st. from the side edge of the top of the shoe, then knit the 10 (12) st. of the upper side of the shoe in plain and also take up 10 (12) M from the other edges of the top of the shoe, then knit the 12 (13) st. of the left side in plain (= 54 (62) st.). Continue knitting in garter stitch over these st., 1. row = return row. After 9 (11) rows, cast off as follows for the sole of the shoe:

10. (12.) row:

1 edge stitch, 3 (4) st. plain, knit 2 st. together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, knit 2 together, slip over in plain (= lift off 1 st. in plain, knit 1 st. in plain, pull lifted st. over knitted st.), 6 (8) st. plain, knit 2 together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, 2 st. together slipped in plain, 3 (4) st. plain, 1 edge stitch (= 50 (58) st.)

11. (13.) row: 1 edge stitch, knit all st. in plain, 1 edge stitch

12. (14.) row:

1 edge stitch, 2 (3) st. plain, knit 2 together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, knit 2 st. together slipped in plain, 4 (6) st. plain, knit 2 together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, knit 2 together slipped in plain, 2 (3) st. plain, 1 edge stitch (= 46 (54) st.)

13. (15.) row: 1 edge stitch, knit all st. in plain, 1 edge stitch

14. (16.) row:

1 edge stitch, 1 (2) st. plain, knit 2 together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, knit 2 st. together slipped in plain, 2 (4) st. plain, knit 2 together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, knit 2 together slipped in plain, 1 (2) st. plain, 1 edge stitch (= 42 (50) st.)

15. (17.) row: 1 edge stitch, knit all st. in plain, 1 edge stitch

16. (18.) row:

1 edge stitch, 0 (1) st. plain, knit 2 together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, knit 2 st. together slipped in plain, 0 (2) st. plain, knit 2 together in plain, 16 (18) st. plain, knit 2 together slipped in plain, 0 (1) st. plain, 1 edge stitch (= 38 (46) st.)

17. (19.) row: 1 edge stitch, knit all st. in plain, 1 edge stitch

only larger sizes:

20. row:

1 edge stitch, 2 st. together in plain, 18 st. plain, knit 2 st. together slipped in plain, knit 2 together in plain, 18 st. plain, knit 2 together slipped in plain, 1 edge stitch (= 42 st.)

21. row: 1 edge stitch, knit all st. in plain, 1 edge stitch

Subsequently, cast off the remaining 38 (42) st. straight, hereby knitting in plain.

Knit the 2. shoe in the same manner.

Finish:

Fold the shoes in half and close the lower sole seam as well as the rear seam as flat as possible.

Make 2 cords and pull them through the row of holes of the two shoes.

Cord (x 2):

finished length: approx. 40-45 cm

Cut 2 treads à approx. 2 m and fashion a cord as describe for the pullover.

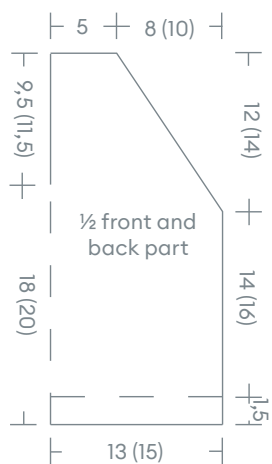
1.row = row(s) facing front

2.row = st. = stitch(es) . . .
