Size: (2 - 4 Years)

Scarf: Length approx. 133 cm,

Hat: Head Circumference
approx. 42 - 45 cm

Usage:

Scarf: each approx. 50 g in col. 09 (light grey),
col. 05 (pastel turquoise), col. 04 (mint) and
col. 03 (pastel blue)

Hat: each approx. 50 g in col. 09 (light grey) und
col. 05 (pastel turquoise)
Pompon-Maker Ø 5,5 cm

Stitch Pattern:

Scarf:

Fisherman's Stitch: (sts multiple of 2 + 4 selvedge sts)

Row 1 (establishing row): k2, * sl 1 p-wise with yo tog, k1, rep from * to end then sl 2 p-wise wyif.

Row 2: k2, * sl 1 p-wise with yo tog, k1 with yo tog, rep from * to end then sl 2 p-wise wyif.

Rows 2 establishes the pattern. Rep cont. throughout.

Hat:

Ribbing worked in Rnds: (sts multiple of 3)

All rnds: * p1, k1, p1, rep from * cont.

Fisherman's Rib and Ribbing Pattern worked in Rnds: (sts multiple of 3)

Rnd 1: * p1, sl 1 p-wise with yo tog, p1, rep from * cont.

Rnd 2: * p1, k1 with yo tog, p1, rep from * cont. These 2 rows establish the pattern. Rep cont. throughout.

Tension: (adjust needle size to achieve given tension)

Scarf: 22 sts and 48 rows to 10 cm meas. over fisherman's stitch using size 3,5 mm needles.

Hat: 26 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm meas. over fisherman's rib stitch using size 3,5 mm needles

Instructions:

Scarf:

Cast on 34 sts (including 4 selvedge sts) and work in Fisherman's stitch according to the following colour repeat: 6 cm (= 29 rows) in col. 09, * 6 cm (= 28 R) each in col. 05 and col. 09, rep from * 1 time more., then 20 cm (= 96 R) each in col. 04, col. 05, col. 03 and col. 09, ** 6 cm (= 28 R) each in col. 05 and col. 09, rep from **

1 time more. When work meas. approx. 133 cm (= 637 R) cast off all sts even in col. 09, alt. p1, k1 with yo tog.

Hat:

Using 3 mm double pointed needles and col 09, cast on 96 sts. Place beg of rnd marker and join ready to work in the round placing 24 sts on each of the 4 needles. Work 4 cm (12 rnds) in ribbing then change to col 05 and work 1 round more in ribbing patt.

Next rnd: change to 3,5mm needles and cont. in fisherman's rib stitch until work meas. 12 cm (= 43 rows) from patt change.

Rnd 44: * p1 and k1 with yo tog., p1, rep from * cont. (= 64 sts)

Rnd 45: * sl 1 p-wise with yo tog, p1, rep from * cont.

Rnd 46: * k1 with yo tog., p1, rep from * cont.

Rnd 47: * sl 1 p-wise with yo tog, p1, rep from * cont.

Rnds 48. + 49: work as rnds 46 and 47

Rnd 50: * sl 1 p-wise with yo tog, p1, pssso rep from * cont. (= 32 sts)

Rnd 51.: k all sts

Rnd 52: k2tog to end (= 16 sts)

Rnd 53: k all sts

Rnd 54: k2tog to end (= 8 sts)

Cut yarn and thread through these 8 rem sts. and pull taught. Weave in ends.

Using col. 09 make a Ø 5,5 cm pompom and attach to top of hat.
