COTTON QUICK UNI

Crochet Skirt

Difficulty level:



Needles:



3 - 4

Quality:

Cotton Quick uni (Gründl)
100 % Cotton (mercerised,
gassed, combed)
50 g / 125 m

Size:

Women's EU size 34/36 [38/40]

Usage:

approx. 300 g in col. 139 (beige)

Pattern:

Flower Circle a: (for the top ring of the skirt)
Work according to chart. Start with an adjustable ring (magic loop) then tr15 into the ring working 3 tch to replace the 1st tr and end the rnd with 1 sl st worked into the 3rd replacement ch from the beg of the rnd (= rnd 1)
Work 2nd and 3rd rnds according to chart. Leave a long tail at the end of each circle to crochet together.

Flower Circle b: (for the 2nd and 3rd rings of the skirt)

Work according to chart. Start with an adjustable ring (magic loop) then
Rnd 1: ch 3, tr2tog, ch2, * tr3tog, ch2, rep from * 6 times more and end rnd with 1 sl st into the 3rd replacement ch from the beg of the rnd. (Work the sts tog by keeping the last loop of each st on the hook and then completing both sts tog)
Rnd 2-3: work according to chart. Working the tr3tog around the ch and in the tr3tog of the previous rnd accordingly.

Rnd 4: beg the rnd with ch1 as replacement for the 1st dc then dc around, working 1 dc around each ch and 1 dc into the tr3tog of the previous rnd. End rnd with 1 sl st onto the replacement ch from the beg of the rnd. Leave a long tail at the end of each circle to crochet together.

Tr in rnds:

Beg each rnd of tr with 3ch as replacement for the 1st tr and ends with 1 sl st into the 3rd replacement ch from the beg of the rnd.

Lace pattern in rnds:

Beg each rnd with 3ch as replacement for the 1st tr, then * ch1 and tr1 into the 2nd next following st of the previous rnd (sk1), rep from * cont and end rnd with 1 sl st into the 3rd replacement tr from the beg of the rnd.

Tension:

Flower Circle a: Ø 7 cm

Flower Circle b: Ø 8 cm

Instructions:

Changes for larger size given in brackets. If only one number is shown, this applies to both sizes.

First work flower circle **a** 11 [12] times. Then crochet the 11 [12] circles into a ring (= ring a). Place the circles with wrong sides facing and adjacent to another and using the long tails crochet together using sl sts along the 8 sts that are next to each other (place the sts only into the upper loop).

Then work flower circle **b** 22 [24] times. Close 11 [12] circles each into a ring (ring b = total of 2) As before, place the circles with wrong sides facing and adjacent to another and using the long tails crochet together using sl sts along the 14 sts that are next to each other (place the sts only into the upper loop).

For the waistband of the skirt, work 1 rnd of tr around the top edge of ring a. Working tr16 per circle (= 176 [192] sts). Then work 1 rnd in lace pattern and 1 rnd tr. In this last round, work tr2 around the ch and no sts into the tr of the prev rnd.

Crochet the lower edge of ring a with 1 rnd of tr, working tr16 per circle (= 176 [192] sts).

Then work 1 rnd onto this lower edge doubling every 8th st (= tr2 into one st) (= 198 [216] sts).

Now work 2 rnds in tr along both the upper and lower edges of rings b, per circle tr18 (= 198 [216] sts).

Place the rings together as show in sketch with the circles staggered above each other. Now join the lower edge of ring a with the upper edge of one ring b:

1 sl st into the 1st st in ring a, ch2, 1 sl st into the facing ring b, * ch2, 1 sl st into the next st on ring a, ch2, 1 sl st into the next st on the facing ring b, rep from * cont. Then connect the lower edge of these rings with the upper edge of the final ring b in the same manor. Work 1 rnd lace pattern and 2 rnds of tr along the bottom edge, working in this first round, tr2 around the ch and no sts into the tr of the prev rnd. To finish work 1 rnd dc along the bottom edge working a picot st over every 6th st (= ch3 and 1 dc into the 1st of these 3 ch sts).

Finishing:

Twist a cord with final meas of 125 [130] cm. To do so cut 2 lengths of yarn, each 4 metre in length and twist together, then fold in half


and allow to twist together. Secure the ends with knots and thread through the lace rnd of the waistband.


Crochet Chart:
