

Pattern LISA PREMIUM UNI



Floor Pillow Cover

Difficulty level:



Needles:



3,0 - 4,0 (UK 11 - 8)

Quality:

Lisa Premium uni (Gründl) 100 % Acrylic 50 g / 133 m

Kissen 1:



1x 3x 3x 5x

Kissen 2:



Size: 59 cm x 59 cm, to fit a pillow inlet size 60 cm x 60 cm

Usage:

Pillow 1: approx. 50 g col. 02 (cream), approx. 150 g col. 49 (petrol), approx. 150 g col. 22 (nougat), approx. 250 g col. 33 (bright green)
Pillow 2: approx. 50 g col. 24 (stone grey), approx. 100 g col. 02 (cream), approx. 100 g col. 49 (petrol), approx. 100 g col. 14 (bright pink), approx. 250 g col. 22 (nougat)
For each pillow: 1 zipper, 40 cm length in coordinating col.

Pattern:

<u>Patt 1:</u> front post treble crochet in rnds to form a square (Front of pillow):

Work as shown in chart.

1st round: Beg with a magic ring or loop, ch 2 (to replace 1st tr), tr 2, ch 2, * tr 2, ch 2. Rep from * 2 times ending with 1 ss in the 2nd replacement ch of the beg of the round.

2nd round: beg with 2 ch and 1 fpt from the front around the 2 replacement ch in the 1st rnd.

Next and every foll. rnd: beg with 2 ch and 1 fpt from the front around the replacement ch and the 1st fpt in the prev rnd. This gives an almost invisible transition between the rnds.

Work 2 htr, 2 ch and 2 htr around the 2 ch of the prev rnd in each corner (An fpt is worked into the htr in the foll rnds.)

Every rnd increases by 16 sts.

<u>Patt 2:</u> half treble crochet in rnds to form a square (Back of pillow):

Work as shown in chart.

1st round: Beg with a magic ring or loop ch 1 (as replacement for the 1st htr), 2 htr, 2 ch, * 3 htr, 2 ch, rep from * 2 times more. End rnd with 1 ss in the replacement st at beg of rnd.

Cont a shown in chart beg each rnd with 1 ch to replace the 1st htr and ending with 1 ss in the replacement ch at the beg of the rnd.

Work 2 htr, 2 ch and 1 htr around the 2 ch of the prev rnd in each corner.

Every rnd increases by 8 sts.

Tension:

Meas over hpt.: after 8 rnd the square meas approx. 14 cm x 14 cm
Meas over htr: after 6 rnds the square meas approx. 10 cm x 10 cm

Col Sequence:

Front of Pillow 1: Work 7 rnds in petrol, 4 rnds in cream, 9 rnds in bright green, 9 rnds in nougat, 5 rnds in petrol

Back of Pillow 1: work completely in bright areen

Front of Pillow 2: 2 rnds in petrol, 2 rnds in stone grey, 2 rnds in cream, 2 rnds in bright pink, 2 rnds in nougat, 4 rnds in petrol, 4 rnds in stone grey, 4 rnds in cream, 4 rnds in bright pink, 4 rnds in nougat, 4 rnds in petrol Back of Pillow 1: work completely in nougat

Instructions:

For the front of the pillows work a square, in the given col sequence for pillow 1 or 2, work in patt 1 until piece meas 59 cm x 59 cm. For the back work a 59 cm x 59 cm square (35 rnds) in patt 2 in the given col.

Sew side seams tog taking care to make the seam as flat as possible holding the outer edges of the pillow front tog as you sew and leaving approx 40 cm open. Sew zipper into opening with matching thread.





Crochet Pattern:

Patt 1:







- \bullet = 1 ch
- + = 1 tr
- =1htr
- = 1 fpt (front post treble around the front of the fpt, bpt or htr of the previous rnd)
- = 1 bpt (back post treble around the back of the fpt, bpt or htr of the previous rnd)
- \frown =1ss
