Size: 36/38 (40/42)

Required quantity:
approx. 300 (350) g

Basic pattern (triangular pattern): (number of stitches can be divided by 5 + 1 st)

1st r (= WSR.): 1 tch, *7 ch, skip 4 st, 1 sc in the 5th st of the previous row, repeat after *, end with 1 sc (in the following r, crochet the sc around the ch of the previous row)

2nd r (= RSR): 5 tch, *4 dc in the middle st of the ch arch underneath, 1 ch, rep. after *, end with a dtr in the last ch of the ch arch underneath
Repeat 1st and 2nd r

Border pattern:

(number of stitches can be divided by 4 + 1 st)
1st r only crochet dc, every r dc begins with 3 ch as replacement for the 1st dc

2nd r: 3 replacement ch, 1 dc in the following st, skip * 1 st of the previous row with 1 ch, ever 1 dc in the following 3 dc of the previous r, repeat after *, end with 1 st of the previous r skip with 1 ch, 1 dc in the last two st of the previous row each
3rd r: only crochet dc

Sleeves and rolled cuffs:

stocking stitch: *RSR.:* knit stitch, *WSR.:* purl stitch; in rd.: only knit stitch

Tension sample:

Basic pattern: 17 st x 6.5 r = 10 cm x 10 cm

stocking stitch: 21 st x 28 r = 10 cm x 10 cm

Pattern: (Deviating instructions for size 40/42 in brackets)

Back part: Cast 81 (91) ch and crochet the 1st to 3rd r of the border pattern 1 x. Then continue to work in triangular pattern. At 55 (58) cm (= 36 (38) r) from the beginning of the triangular pattern in the following WSR for the backw. neckline, work as follows: 6 (7) pattern sets (1 pattern set = 1 triangle made of 4 dc and 1 ch) crochet as per pattern, skip the following 4 pattern sets with ch and continue to basic pattern over the last 6 (7) pattern sets. Then, end both sides separately. for the left shoulder (worn), crochet 5 (6) pattern sets as per pattern. in the following 6th (7th) ch arch of the previous r only crochet 1 dc in the middle st. End the should with 1 r sc.

For the right shoulder (worn), crochet in the inner cutout end in the middle st of the 1st ch arch only 3 replacement ch, then end the r as per pattern. Crochet 1 r sc.

Front part: Work like the back part, however at a height of 40 (43) cm (= 26 (28) r) from basic pattern work the front neckline like the back part. End the front part at the same height as the back part with 1 r sc.

Sleeves: First close the shoulder seams flat. Use the round needle to take the side edges of the front and back parts over a total of 38 (40) cm (19 (20) cm each on front and back part) approx. 80 (84) st. Start with a WSR and knit stocking stitch 8.5 cm (= 23 r). For the sleeve shaping decrease 3 x i.e. 6th r 1 st each on both sides, by k tog 2 st slip decrease on the ri work edge after the edge stitch. (= decrease 1 st, k 1, pass over the decreased stitch) and k tog ri both st before the edge stitch on the le work edge (= 74 (78) st). Bind off all st straight and work the second sleeve in the same manner.

Finishing: Finish side and sleeve seams flat. Crochet around with 1 rd. sc. With a round needle, cast approx. 180 st on the border for the rolled edge and knit 5 rd stocking stitch. Then bind off all st straight.

st = stitch
 rd. = round
 r = row
 RSR = right-side row
 WSR = wrong-side row
 sc = single crochet
 dc = double crochet
 ch = chain stitch
 tch = turning chain
 sl st = slip stitch
 ri = right
 le = left
 rep. = repeat
 i.e. = in every
