Merino Pure from Gründl
100 % Virgin Wool
(extra fine merino, superwash)
50 g / 120 m

Size:

Size S (M - L):
approx. 13,5 (15 - 16,5) cm
circumference

Usage:

approx. 20 g Merino Pure in colours desired (as shown here: col. 02 (natural), col. 03 (beige), col. 05 (chocolate) and col. 24 (light grey), 2 oval wobble eyes 6 mm x 10 mm, small amount of Cotton Quick uni in col. 110 (mouse grey) and col. 01 (white)

Tension:

22 sts and 26 rnds to 10 cm meas over dc in spiral rnds.

Stitch Pattern:

DC in Spiral Rounds: The dcs are worked continuously in spiral rnds starting the new rnd directly after the previous rnd without a slip stitch. Mark the first st of each new rnd with a stitch marker or a contrast piece of yarn. This helps when counting rnds.

Instructions:

(changes for larger sizes shown in brackets)

Version 1: (with face and ears)

Head:

Make a magic ring and dc6 into the ring (= rnd 1). Cont dcs in spiral rnds.

Rnd 2: double each st (= work 2 dcs into each st) (= 12 sts)

Rnd 3: double each 2nd st. (= 18 sts)

Rnd 4: double each 3rd st. (= 24 sts)

Rnd 5: double each 4th st. (= 30 sts)

[size M: **Rnd 6:** double every 10th st (= 33 sts)]

[size L: **Rnd 6:** double every 5th st (= 36 sts)]

Now work 10 more rnds without incs and 1 last rnd with sl sts.

Ears: (work 2 alike)

Make a magic ring and dc6 into the ring (= rnd 1). Cont dcs in spiral rnds.

Rnd 2: double each st (= 12 sts)

Rnd 3: double every 4th st (= 15 sts)

Rnds 4 - 13: dcl5 (without incs).

Fold opening together and sew closed.

Finishing:

Sew the ears to the top of the head so the ears point up and one ear stands to the right. Knot a bushel of hair between the ears. Embroider the nose and whiskers using Cotton Quick uni in light grey, diving the yarn into thinner strands for the whiskers. Then glue on the eyes. Stitch the eyebrows using light grey and white for the teeth, dividing the yarn for the teeth as before.

Weave in ends.

Version 2:

(cosy with bunny ears)

Work rnds 1 - 12 as for variation 1 and end with 1 rnd of sl sts. Also work the ears as for variation 1 and sew on so both ears stand upwards.

Abbreviations:

approx. = approximate(ly)

beg = begin(ning)

col = colour(s)

cont = continue (continuously)

dc = double crochet

meas = measure(d)

rnd(s) = round(s)

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)
