Children's Oversized Jumper

Quality:

Happy Kiddy from Gründl 100 % Polyacrylic (Non-Pilling) 100 g / 250 m

Size: EU children's size 104 - 122 (128 - 140)

Usage:

approx. 300 (400) g in col. 07 (peach print)

Stitch Pattern:

Ribbina Pattern: (in rows)

WS: alt k1, p1 cont. throughout and end row with k1 RS: work the sts as they appear (k the knit sts and p the purl sts)

Ribbing Pattern: (in rnds.)

alt k1, p1 throughout.

Double Seed Stitch:

Row 1: (= RS): alt k1, p1 cont. throughout and end row with k1

Row 2: (and all following WS rows): work the sts as they appear

Row 3: alt p1, k1 cont. throughout and end row

Rows 1 – 4 establish the pattern. Rep these 4 rows cont. throughout.

Selvedge Stitches:

At beg of row sl 1 k-wise first st and end of row sl 1 p-wise wyif.

Tip for Colour Sequence:

To achieve a harmonious color change start the new piece at the same place in the colour sequence as the last piece. Start ALL balls consistently either from the inside or the outside.

25 sts and 33 rows to 10 cm meas over double seed st pattern using size 3-4 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

Instructions: (changes for larger size are shown in brackets)

Back:

Cast on 89 [103] sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and beginning with a WS row, work 6 cm (= 17 rows) in ribbing between the selvedge sts. Then cont in double seed st.

When work meas total of 39 [47] cm (= 129 [155] rows) work the shoulder shaping. Cast of 5 [7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. Then at beg of every following row cast off 6 [7] sts 6 times. AT THE SAME TIME when work meas 40 [48] cm (= 131 [159] rows) place the centre 31 [35] sts on a holder for the back neckline and work both sides of the neck separately. In every alt row at the neck edge cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once.

Front:

Work as for back but for the lower neckline opening when work meas total height of 37 [45] cm (= 121 [149] rows) place the centre 23 [27] sts onto a holder and work both sides of the neck separately. In every alt row at the neck edge cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st three times. AT THE SAME TIME work the shoulder shaping as for back.

Sleeves: (make two alike)

Cast on 43 [51] sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and beginning with a WS row, work 5 cm (= 15 rows) of ribbing between the selvedge sts. Then cont in double seed st patt. For the side shaping in every 4th row on both sides inc 1 st (M1 tbl after and before the selvedge st working the new sts into patt as established) 16 [18] times (= 75 [87] sts). Then work straight until total height of 26 [33] cm (= 87 [109] cm). Next row: cast off all sts even in patt.

Finishing:

Close shoulder seams. For the neckline ribbing, with right sides facing and dpns, pick up 88 [98] sts along neckline edge and work 6 – 8 cm in ribbing in rnds. Then cast off all sts loosely in patt. Sew in sleeves. Close side and sleeve seams. Weave in ends.

WS = wrong side
