COTTON QUICK BATIK

Granny Square Pillow Case

Difficulty Level:



Needles:



3,0 – 4,0

Quality:

Cotton Quick Batik from Gründl
100 % Cotton (mercerised, gas-
sed, combed)
100 g / 260 m



3 x

Size:

Pillow approx. 40 cm x 40 cm

Usage:

approx. 300 g in col. 01 (light
blue- violet - apple green)
Heart-shaped wooden buttons
from Gründl Art # 1447-5

Pattern:(refer to chart)

Tr in rnds: start every rnd with 3tch to replace
the first tr and end each rnd with 1 sl st worked
into the third sl st from the beginning.

Tension:

24 sts (= 6 x (2tr + 1 ch)) and 12 rnds to 10 cm using
size 3-4mm needles or size needed to achieve
given tension.

Instructions:

The pillow is worked as a large square in the
round.

Make a magic ring and work the first rnd as
follows into the ring: ch3, tr2, *ch3, tr3 rep from
* twice more, ch3 and end rnd with 1 sl st worked
into the 3rd ch at the beg of rnd. Continue as
given in chart. Then continue increasing logical-
ly in established pattern until the sides of the
square meas approx 56 cm (approx. 34 rnds).
Place the square with right side facing and fold
the four corners onto the centre of the square
(= square approx. 40 x 40 cm side length). Now
on the wrong side of the pillow, crochet 2 of the
4 matching diagonal sides together using sl sts.
Place the needle only into the back loop of the
st. Crochet the remaining two diagonal seams
together leaving a 15 cm opening in the centre.
Crochet around the edges of the opening (tri-
angle). Place the pillow into the cover through
the opening.


Sew a heart-shaped button on the other side of
the opening and close the corner of the open
triangle. As desired sew additional heart-sha-
ped buttons along the open edge and close
with the facing chain sts.


