## COTTON QUICK UNI

### Top with moss stitch

#### Difficulty level:



#### Needles:



3,0 – 4,0

2,5 – 3,0

#### Quality:

Cotton Quick uni (Gründl)  
100 % Cotton (mercerised,  
gassed, combed)  
50 g / 125 m

#### Size:

34/36 (38/40)

#### Consumption:

approx. 250 g colour 116 (limette)  
and/or colour 108 (orchidee)

#### Pattern:

##### Stripe pattern:

Knit 10 r stocking stitch and 6 r double moss  
stitch alternately

##### stocking stitch:

right-side-row: knit plain., return row; knit purl

##### double moss stitch:

1. r (= right-side-row): knit alternately 1 plain and  
1 purl.

2. r (= return row): between edge st, knit as they  
appear

3. r: knit 1 st. purl and 1 st. plain alternately be-  
tween edge st.

4. r: knit between edge st as they appear

Keep repeating 1–4.

##### Knotted edge stitch:

At beginning of the row, slip st as if knitting  
plain, at the end of the row knit plain.

##### Emphasised decrease:

At beginning of the row, knit the two st after the  
edge st together (= lift off 1 st as if knitting plain,  
knit following st plain, then lift slipped st over  
the knitted), then knit row according to pat-  
tern up to 3 st (incl. edges stitch) before end of  
row, then knit the two st before the edge stitch  
together in plain.

##### Crochet sc in row:

Each row of sc begins with 1 ch as replacement  
for the 1. sc and ends with 1 slip st in the replace-  
ment ch of the start of the round.

##### **Stitch test:** (Stripe sample)

25 st x 34 r = 10 cm x 10 cm

**Instructions:** (deviating information for size  
38/40 are in brackets)

##### Back:

Cast on 104 (114) st. plus 2 edge stitches. start  
with return row purl, then knit in stripe pattern.  
In the process, decrease emphasised on both  
sides 1 st 5 x in each 8 row. (= 96 (106) st.). At a  
total height of 18 (20) cm (= 61 (69) r) increase  
1 st on both sides in the following right-side-row  
from casting on of the side shaping. (= at the

beginning of the row after the edge stitch and at the end before the edge stitch, add 1 st. each in plain and/or purl twisted from the cross thread) (= 98 (105) st). Add 2 x more in each 18. (20.) r (= 102 (112) st). At a total height of 32 (34) cm (= 109 (117) r) decrease on both sides for the armhole 1 x 5 st, then in each 2. r again 1 x 3 st, 1 x 2 st and 4 (6) x 1 st (= 74 (80) st). At a total height of 46 (49) cm (= 157 (167) r) cast off the 34 (36) st for the back of the neck and finish both sides separately. For internal round, cast off in each 2. r 1 x 3 st, 1 x 2 st, and 2 x 1 st in every 2. row. At a total height of 50 (53) cm (= 171 (181) r) cast off the remaining 13 (15) shoulder stitches straight. Finish 2. side in mirror image.

**Front:**

Work as back, but for deeper neckline cast off at 34 (36) cm (= 115 (123) r) the centre 20 (22) st and finish sides separately. For internal round, cast off in each 2. r 1 x 5 st, 1 x 3 st, 1 x 2 st, and 4 x 1 st. Cast off remaining 13 (15) st at the same height as back. Finish 2. side in mirror image.

**Completion:**

Close shoulder and side seems. Crochet around armholes and neck line edges with 2 rounds of sc.

**Abbreviations:**

- st. = stitch(es)
- r = row(s)
- sc = single crochet
