

# **Pattern HAPPY TUBE**



## **Basket Crocheted in Knit Stitch**

#### Difficulty level:



#### **Needles:**



10 - 12

#### Quality:

Happy Tube from Gründl 70 % Cotton. 30 % Polyamide 150 g / 90 m



1 x

#### Size:

Circumference: approx. 13 cm, height: approx. 12 cm

Usage: approx. 150 g Extras:

1 Handmade button from Gründl. Art.-No. 1447-6

2 cm wide artificial leather band, length: approx. 12 cm

#### Stitch Pattern:

Dc in spiral-rnds: (bottom)

The rnds are worked in a continuous manner. There is not a sl st at the end of each rnd. Mark the beg of each rnd with a marker or contrast piece of varn.

Knit stich or woven stitch in spiral rnds: (see sketch and images as reference)

Work each st as a dc, do not put the needle into the top 2 loops of the stich but place the needle under the horizontal bar and between the 2 vertical bars directly below the new stitch.









#### Tension:

8 sts and 11 rnds to 10 cm meas over knit stitch pattern.

#### Instructions:

Start work at the bottom. Cast on 2 ch Rnd 1: work 6 dc into the first ch.

Rnd 2: double each st (= work 2 dc into each st) (= 12 sts)

Rnd 3: double each  $2^{nd}$  st (= 18 sts)

Rnd 4: double each 3<sup>rd</sup> st (= 24 sts)

Rnd 5: double each 4th st (= 30 sts)

Rnd 6: dc without incs, working each st only into the back loop

Rnd 7: dc without incs

Rnd 8 – 19: work in knit stitch in spiral rnds over the 30 sts.

Rnd 20: work sl sts and end rnd with 1 sl st worked into the 1st stitch of the rnd. Cut yarn and pull through last loop.

#### Finishina:

Cut a small slit approx. 1 cm from the edge along both ends of the artificial leather band. Fold the band in half (6 cm) and along with the button, sew onto the top edge of the basket as shown. To do

so, cut a 15 cm long piece of Happy Tube and pull through the button holes and through the slits in the band approx. 5 cm from the edge of the basket. Fold the band over the top edge to the inside and pull the yarn through the slits on the band on the inside of the basket. Tie the ends into knots and weave in ends.
