

Pattern BIG COLOUR TWIST

Hat with Pompon & Infinity Scarf in Brioche Pattern

Needles: Infinity Scarf:





Quality:

Big Colour Twist (Gründl) 100 % polyacrylic 200 g / 312 m

Infinity Scarf:
Width: approx. 22 cm, Circumference: approx. 125 cm

Usage:

Infinity Scarf: approx. 200 g Hat with Pompon: approx. 200 g

Stitch Pattern:

Brioche Pattern with Double Selvedge Stitches:
(amount of sts multiple of 2 + 1 + 4 selvedge sts)

Row 1 (= WS row): 2 selvedge sts, * k1, sl1 p-wise
with yo, rep from * to last 3 sts,
then k1, 2 selvedge sts.

Row 2 (= RS row): 2 selvedge sts, * sll p-wise with yo, k2tog (sl st and yo of previous row), rep from * to last 3 sts, then sll p-wise with yo, 2 selvedge sts.

Row 3: 2 selvedge sts, * k2tog (sl st and yo of previous row), sl1 p-wise with yo, rep from * and end row with k2tog (sl st and yo of previous row) and 2 selvedge sts.

These rows establish the pattern. Rep rows 2 and 3 cont throughout.

Double Selvedge Stitch (2 selvedge sts): Work the first two sts in each row: k2 and and last two sts: sl 2 p-wise wyif.

Ribbing in Rounds: (hat, amount of sts multiple of 2)

Alt k1, p1 cont throughout.

Garter Stitch with Brioche Ribbing in Rounds: (hat, amount of sts multiple of 4)

Rnd 1: alt k3, 1 brioche st (= sl1 p-wise with yo)
Rnd 2: alt p3, 1 brioche st (k2tog (= sl st and yo of previous rnd))

Garter Stitch in Rounds: (hat)

Rnd 1: knit all sts Rnd 2: purl all sts

Rnds 1-2 establish the patt. Rep these 2 rnds cont.

Tip:

The hat doesn't have a right side or wrong side and can be worn on both sides. On the one side the brioche sts are more noticeable and on the other side the garter st ribs are more three-dimensional.

Tension:

(Infinity Scarf) 13 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm meas over brioche st patt using size 6 - 7 mm needles

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or size needed to achieve given tension.
(hat): 20 sts and 23 rnds to 10 cm meas, slightly stretched, over ribbing using size 5 - 6 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

(hat): 17 sts and 30 rnds to 10 cm meas over garter st with brioche ribs using size 5 -6 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

Instructions:

Infinity Scarf:

Cast on 32 sts (28 sts in patt and 4 selvedge sts). Work in brioche patt as given with double selvedge sts until scarf meas 125 cm. Then cast off alls sts loosely working the sts with yos as knit sts and the sts in between as purl. Sew cast on and cast off edges together as flat as possible.

Hat:

Cast on 72 sts and divide amongst 4 dpns (= 4 x 18 sts), close round making sure not to twist the sts. Work 13 cm in ribbing patt (= 28 rnds). Then cont in garter st with brioche patt. When hat meas total of 15 cm from cast on (= 44 rnds) work the decs as follows:

Rnd 73: k2tog the 2 sts before every brioche st and cont to work the patt as established. (= 54 sts)

Rnds 74 - 76: work straight without decs and cont the patt as established, that means 2 sts in garter st between the brioche sts.

Rnd 77: k2tog between the brioche sts, working the brioche sts as established (= 36 sts)


Rnds 78 - 80: work straight without decs and work the pat as established, that means 1 garter st between the brioche sts.

Rnd 81: k2tog to end of rnd (= 18 sts)
Rnd 82: k2tog to end of rnd (= 9 sts)
Cut yarn and slip through the remaining 9 sts,
pull taught to close hole. Make a pompon
9 cm in diameter and attach to top of hat.
Weave in ends. Fold back ribbing 7 cm.
