# JINGLE BALL

## Hat with Mock Fisherman's Ribbing Pattern & Pompom

### Difficulty level:



### Needles:



5 - 6

### Quality:

Jingle Ball (Gründl)  
98 % acrylic, 2 % polyester  
100 g / 160 m

### Size:

Head circumference: approx. 54 cm - 56 cm

### Usage:

approx. 100 g

### Pattern:

(mock fisherman's rib, amount of sts multiple of 4)  
*Rnd 1:* k2, \*p1, k3, rep from \* cont. and end rnd with p1, k1.

*Rnd 2:* \* k1, p3, rep from \* cont. to end of rnd. Rnds 1 and 2 establish the pattern. Rep cont. throughout.

### Tension:

20 sts and 27 rnds to 10 cm meas over mock fisherman's rib using size 5 - 6 mm needles or size needed.

### Instructions:

Cast on 80 sts and divide evenly amongst 4 dpns (20 sts per needle). Close rnd being careful not to twist the sts. Work 17 cm (= 45 rnds) in pattern. Then work decs on crown as foll:

*Rnd 46:* \* k1, p2tog, p1, rep from \* cont. (= 60 sts)

*Rnd 47:* k all sts without decs.

*Rnd 48:* \* k1, p2, rep from \* to end.

*Rnd 49:* k all sts without decs.

*Rnd 50:* \* k1, p2tog, k1, p2, rep from \* to end (= 50 sts)

*Rnd 51:* k all sts without decs.

*Rnd 52:* \* k1, p1, k1, p2tog, rep from \* to end (= 40 sts)

*Rnd 53:* k all sts without decs.

*Rnd 54:* \*skp (sl 1 k-wise, k1, pss0) rep from \* to end (= 20 sts)

*Rnd 55:* k all sts without decs.

*Rnd 56:* skp to end (= 10 sts)

Cut yarn and pull through the remaining 10 sts. Pull yarn taught to close opening.

### Tip:

pull yarn through last stitches a couple of times to avoid a hole

### Finishing:

Using the remaining yarn from the ball make a pompom with approx. 6 - 7 cm diameter and attach to the top of the hat. Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations:

approx. = approximate(ly)

cont = continue (continuously)  
dec(s) = decrease(s)  
k = knit  
k-wise = knit wise  
patt = pattern  
p = purl  
pss0 = pass slipped stitch over prev  
knit st(s)  
rep = repeat  
rnd(s) = round(s)  
skp = sl 1, k1, pss0  
sl = slip  
st(s) = stitch(es)  
tog = together

**Pompon:**
