## Teddy Paul

Difficulty level:
(2) (2)

Needles:


3,0-3,5
Quality:
Cotton Fun (Gründl)
100 \% cotton
50 g / 115 m


Size:
Height (when sitting): approx. 22 cm

## sage:

Approx. 50 g each of
col. 1 (brown), col. 2 (green) and col. 3 (blue), approx. 3 m black, approx. 80 g synthetic wool

## Pattern:

cr in spiral rounds: The scr are continuously cro cheted in spirals across the start of the round. Mark the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of every rd. with a contrasting thread or a stitch marker.
Colour change: When changing colours, work the last st in the new col.
Tension sample (single crochets):

## $23 \mathrm{st} \times 22 \mathrm{rd}$. $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Pattern:

Warning: All parts of the teddy must be crocheted very tightly, i.e. always follow the tension sample to ensure that the synthetic wool is held tightly in the inside of the crocheted parts and cannot be easily pulled out. The individual parts must be sewn together very tightly and all threads carefully sewn up to ensure that no parts or the embroidered facial contours come off or can be pulled off easily!
Body: (started on the bottom end)
Crochet 6 scr in col. 3 in a thread ring (= $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{rd}$.). continue to crochet scr in spiral rounds up to and including rd. 19 in col. 3 , then crochet the rd. in the col. stated:
$2^{\text {nd }}$ rd.: dup. every st (= 2 scr in 1 stitching point) (= 12 st )
$3^{\text {rd }}$ rd.: dup. every $2^{\text {nd }}$ st (= 18 st) $4^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $3^{\text {rd }}$ st (= 24 st $5^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $4^{\text {th }}$ st $(=30 \mathrm{st})$ $6^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $5^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=36 \mathrm{st}$ ) $7^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $6^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=42 \mathrm{st}$ ) $8^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $7^{\text {th }}$ st $(=48 \mathrm{st}$ ) $9^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $8^{\text {th }}$ st (= 54 st) $10^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $9^{\text {th }}$ st (= 60 st) $17^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $10^{\text {th }}$ st (= 66 st ) $12^{\text {th }}-19^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without inc.
$20^{\text {th }}+21^{\text {st }}$ rd.: (col. 2) crochet scr without inc.
$22^{\text {nd }}$ rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every $10^{\text {th }}+11^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=60 \mathrm{st}$ ) $23^{\text {rd }}$ rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec.
$24^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every $9^{\text {th }}+10^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=54 \mathrm{st}$ ) $25^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 2) crochet scr without dec $26^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every $8^{\text {th }}+9^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=48 \mathrm{st}$ )
$27^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec.
$28^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every $7^{\text {th }}+8^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=42 \mathrm{st}$ ) $29^{\text {th }}$ rd.: ( (col. 2) crochet scr without dec.
$30^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every $6^{\text {th }}+7^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=36$ st) $31^{\text {st }}$ rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec.
$32^{\text {nd }}$ rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every $5^{\text {th }}+6^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=30$ st) $33^{\text {rd }}$ rd.: (col. 2) crochet scr without dec.
$34^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every $4^{\text {th }}+5^{\text {th }}$ st $(=24$ st)
$35^{\text {th }}$ rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec. (= end of the body)
Stuff the body with synthetic wool.
Head: (crochet in col. brown directly on the body) $33^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without dec.
$37^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $2^{\text {nd }}$ st ( $=36$ st)
$38^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $3^{\text {rd }}$ st ( $=48 \mathrm{st}$ )
$39^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without inc.
$40^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $4^{\text {th }}$ st $(=60$ st)
$41^{\text {st }}$ rd.: crochet scr without inc.
$42^{\text {nd }} r$ rd.: dup. every $10^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=66$ st)
$43^{\text {rd }}-46^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without inc.
$47^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $10^{\text {th }}$ and $11^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=60 \mathrm{st}$ ) $49^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=54 \mathrm{st}$ ) $51^{\text {st }}$ rd.: work tog. every $8^{\text {th }}$ and $9^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=48 \mathrm{st}$ ) $53^{\text {rd }} r$.d.: work tog. every $5^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=40 \mathrm{st}$ ) $55^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=32$ st) $57^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=24$ st)
Crochet the rd. in between without dec. Now start stuffing the body.
$58^{\text {th }} \mathrm{rd}$.: crochet scr without decreases
$59^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ st ( $=16 \mathrm{st}$ )
$60^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every 2 st (= 8 st)
Stuff the head full and close the opening.

## Legs (2 x ):

Crochet 6 scr in col. 1 in a thread ring ( $=1^{\text {st }}$ rd.), continue to crochet scr in spiral rounds in col. 1:
$2^{\text {nd }}$ rd.: dup. every st ( $=12$ st)
$3^{\text {rd }}$ rd.: dup every. $2^{\text {nd }}$ st ( $=18 \mathrm{st}$ )
$4^{\text {th }}$ rd.: dup. every $3^{\text {rd }}$ st $(=24 \mathrm{st})$
$5^{\text {th }}-10^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without increases
Now end the legs in col. 3:
$17^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $7^{\text {th }}+8^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=21 \mathrm{st}$ )
$12^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without decreases
$13^{\text {th }} \mathrm{rd}$.: work tog. every $6^{\text {th }}+7^{\text {th }} \mathrm{st}(=18 \mathrm{st}$ )
$14^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without decreases
$15^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $5^{\text {th }}+6^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=15 \mathrm{st}$ )
$16^{\text {th }}-26^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without decreases

## Arms (2x):

Work like the legs, but in this colour sequence: $1{ }^{\text {st }}-10^{\text {th }}$ rd.: col. 1
$17^{\text {th }}-26^{\text {th }}$ rd.: alternately crochet 3 rd. in col. 2 and 1 rd . in col 3.

Little tail ( $1 \times$ in col. 1):
$\frac{1}{}{ }^{\text {stt }}-3^{r d}$ rd.: crochet like the legs ( $=18 \mathrm{st}$ )
$4^{4 \text { th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without inc.
$5^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ st $(=12$ st)
Stuff the little tail with synthetic wool.
$\mathrm{b}^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every 2 st (= 6 st
Close the opening.
Ears (2 x in col. 1):
Crochet like the $1^{\text {st }}-8^{\text {th }}$ rd. of the legs,
Mouth ( $1 \times$ in col. 1):
Crochet like the $\mathrm{l}^{\mathrm{st}^{\text {t }}}-7^{\text {th }} \mathrm{rd}$. of the legs.

## Heart (in col. 2):

The heart is started at the top. To start with, crochet 2 hemispheres:
Crochet the $1^{\text {st }}-4^{\text {th }}$ rd. like the legs ( $=24 \mathrm{st}$ )
$5^{\text {th }}+6^{\text {th }}$ rd.: crochet scr without inc.
Cut off the thread of the $1^{\text {st }}$ hemisphere, continue to work with the thread of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ hemisphere and crochet the two hemispheres together as follows:
$7^{\text {th }}$ rd.: Crochet 1 scr in the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of the following rd. of the $1^{\text {st }}$ hemisphere, crochet the remaining 23 st with scr, then crochet the 24 st of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ hemisphere with $\mathrm{scr}(=48 \mathrm{st})$
$8^{\text {th }} \mathrm{rd}$.: crochet scr without dec.
$9^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $15^{\text {th }}$ and $16^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=45 \mathrm{st}$ )
$10^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $14^{\text {th }}$ and $15^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=42 \mathrm{st}$ )
$17^{\text {th }}$ rd.: work tog. every $13^{\text {th }}$ and $14^{\text {th }}$ st ( $=39 \mathrm{st}$ )
Continue these decreases accordingly in every rd. ( $=3$ st less per rd.) until there are only 6 st remaining, in the process start to stuff in the $18^{\text {th }}$ rd. Stuff to the top and close the opening.
Completion:
Only half stuff the arms and legs. Leave the upper halves free. Fold the opening flat and sew together the arms and the legs (see illustration). Fold the ears flat (these are not stuffed) and sew onto the top of the head. Stuff the mouth and attach to the front of the head in an oval shape (see illustration). Embroider the facial contours in black (see illustration).
