Needles:



3.0 - 3.5

Quality:

Cotton Fun (Gründl) 100 % cotton 50 g / 115 m







1 x 1 x

Size:

Height (when sitting): approx. 22 cm

Usage:

Approx. 50 g each of col. 1 (brown), col. 2 (green) and col. 3 (blue), approx. 3 m black, approx. 80 g synthetic wool

Pattern:

scr in spiral rounds: The scr are continuously crocheted in spirals across the start of the round. Mark the 1st st of every rd. with a contrasting thread or a stitch marker.

Colour change: When changing colours, work the last st in the new col.

Tension sample (single crochets): 23 st x 22 rd. = 10 cm x 10 cm

Pattern:

Warning: All parts of the teddy must be crocheted very tightly, i.e. always follow the tension sample to ensure that the synthetic wool is held tightly in the inside of the crocheted parts and cannot be easily pulled out. The individual parts must be sewn together very tightly and all threads carefully sewn up to ensure that no parts or the embroidered facial contours come off or can be pulled off easily!

Body: (started on the bottom end)

Crochet 6 scr in col. 3 in a thread ring (= 1st rd.). Continue to crochet scr in spiral rounds up to and including rd. 19 in col. 3, then crochet the rd. in the col. stated:

2nd rd.: dup. every st (= 2 scr in 1 stitching point) (= 12 st)

3rd rd.: dup. every 2nd st (= 18 st)

4th rd.: dup. every 3rd st (= 24 st) 5th rd.: dup. every 4th st (= 30 st)

6th rd.: dup. every 5th st (= 36 st)

7th rd.: dup. every 6th st (= 42 st)

8th rd.: dup. every 7th st (= 48 st)

9th rd.: dup. every 8th st (= 54 st)

10th rd.: dup. every 9th st (= 60 st)

11th rd.: dup. every 10th st (= 66 st)

12th - 19th rd.: crochet scr without inc.

20th + 21st rd.: (col. 2) crochet scr without inc.

 $22^{nd} rd.:$ (col. 2) work tog. every $10^{th} + 11^{th}$ st (= 60 st)

23rd rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec.

 $24^{th} rd.:$ (col. 2) work tog. every $9^{th} + 10^{th}$ st (= 54 st)

25th rd.: (col. 2) crochet scr without dec.

 $26^{th} rd.$: (col. 2) work tog. every $8^{th} + 9^{th}$ st (= 48 st)

27th rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec. 28th rd.: (col. 2) work tog, every 7th + 8th st (= 42 st) 29th rd.: (col. 2) crochet scr without dec. $30^{th} rd.:$ (col. 2) work tog. every $6^{th} + 7^{th}$ st (= 36 st) 31st rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec. $32^{nd} rd.$: (col. 2) work tog. every $5^{th} + 6^{th}$ st (= 30 st) 33rd rd.: (col. 2) crochet scr without dec. 34th rd.: (col. 2) work tog. every 4th + 5th st (= 24 st) 35th rd.: (col. 3) crochet scr without dec. (= end of the body)

Stuff the body with synthetic wool.

Head: (crochet in col. brown directly on the body) 36th rd.: crochet scr without dec. 37th rd.: dup. every 2nd st (= 36 st) 38th rd.: dup. every 3rd st (= 48 st) 39th rd.: crochet scr without inc. 40th rd.: dup. every 4th st (= 60 st) 41st rd.: crochet scr without inc. 42nd rd.: dup. every 10th st (= 66 st) 43rd - 46th rd.: crochet scr without inc. 47^{th} rd.: work tog. every 10^{th} and 11^{th} st (= 60 st) 49th rd.: work tog, every 9th and 10th st (= 54 st) 51st rd.: work tog. every 8th and 9th st (= 48 st) 53^{rd} rd.: work tog. every 5^{th} and 6^{th} st (= 40 st) 55^{th} rd.: work tog. every 4^{th} and 5^{th} st (= 32 st) 57^{th} rd.: work tog. every 3^{rd} and 4^{th} st (= 24 st)

Crochet the rd. in between without dec. Now start stuffing the body.

58th rd.: crochet scr without decreases 59^{th} rd.: work tog. every 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} st (= 16 st) 60th rd.: work tog. every 2 st (= 8 st) Stuff the head full and close the opening.

Leas (2 x):

Crochet 6 scr in col. 1 in a thread ring (= 1st rd.), continue to crochet scr in spiral rounds in col. 1: 2nd rd.: dup. every st (= 12 st) 3rd rd.: dup every. 2nd st (= 18 st) 4th rd.: dup. every 3rd st (= 24 st) 5th - 10th rd.: crochet scr without increases

Now end the leas in col. 3:

 $11^{th} rd.$: work tog. every $7^{th} + 8^{th}$ st (= 21 st) 12th rd.: crochet scr without decreases $13^{th} rd.:$ work tog. every $6^{th} + 7^{th}$ st (= 18 st) 14th rd.: crochet scr without decreases $15^{th} rd.$: work tog. every $5^{th} + 6^{th}$ st (= 15 st)

16th - 26th rd.: crochet scr without decreases

Arms (2 x):

Work like the legs, but in this colour sequence: 1st - 10th rd.: col. 1 11th - 26th rd.: alternately crochet 3 rd. in col. 2 and 1 rd. in col 3.

Little tail $(1 \times in \text{ col. } 1)$:

 $1^{st} - 3^{rd} rd$: crochet like the leas (= 18 st) 4th rd.: crochet scr without inc. 5^{th} rd.: work tog. every 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} st (= 12 st) Stuff the little tail with synthetic wool. 6^{th} rd.: work tog. every 2 st (= 6 st)

Close the opening.

Ears $(2 \times in \text{ col. } 1)$:

Crochet like the 1st - 8th rd. of the legs.

Mouth (1 x in col. 1):

Crochet like the 1st - 7th rd. of the legs.

Heart (in col. 2):

The heart is started at the top. To start with, crochet 2 hemispheres:

Crochet the 1st - 4th rd. like the legs (= 24 st) 5th + 6th rd.: crochet scr without inc.

Cut off the thread of the 1st hemisphere, continue to work with the thread of the 2nd hemisphere and crochet the two hemispheres together as follows: 7th rd.: Crochet 1 scr in the 1st st of the following rd. of the 1st hemisphere, crochet the remaining 23 st with scr. then crochet the 24 st of the

2nd hemisphere with scr (= 48 st)

8th rd.: crochet scr without dec.

 9^{th} rd.: work tog. every 15^{th} and 16^{th} st (= 45 st) $10^{th} \, rd$: work tog. every 14^{th} and 15^{th} st (= 42 st) 17^{th} rd.: work tog. every 13^{th} and 14^{th} st (= 39 st)

Continue these decreases accordingly in every rd. (= 3 st less per rd.) until there are only 6 st remaining, in the process start to stuff in the 18th rd. Stuff to the top and close the opening.

Completion:

Only half stuff the arms and leas. Leave the upper halves free. Fold the opening flat and sew together the arms and the legs (see illustration). Fold the ears flat (these are not stuffed) and sew onto the top of the head. Stuff the mouth and attach to the front of the head in an oval shape (see illustration). Embroider the facial contours in black (see illustration).

col. = colour(s)rd. = round(s)st = stitch(es) scr = single crochet(s) ch. = chain stitch(es) dup. = duplicate work toa. = work toaether dec. = decrease(s) inc. = increase(s)
