
## PASTELLO

### Sweater with Circular Yoke

#### Difficulty level:



#### Needles:



#### Quality:

Pastello from Gründl  
58 % Cotton,  
42 % Polyacrylic  
200 g / 400 m



**2 (3) x**  
eventually 1  
additional ball

**Size:** Women's EU size 36/38  
[40/42 - 44/46]

**Usage:** approx. 400 [600 - 600]  
g in col. 02 (mottled mauve-opal  
pastel colour)  
and to achieve an even color  
gradiations, eventually 1 additio-  
nal ball of yarn per size.

#### Tension:

18 sts and 24 rnds to 10 cm meas over stockinette stitch using size 5 - 6 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

#### Stitch Pattern: (in rounds)

Ribbing: alt k1, p1.

Stockinette stitch: knit all sts.

#### Tips for colour gradient:

To achieve a harmonious colour gradient, when starting each new ball or piece be careful to use the same part of the colour repeat when beginning to knit. This can increase material consumption. Also, consistently start all balls either from the inside or the outside.

#### Instructions:

(Changes for larger sizes given in brackets. If only one number is shown, this applies to all sizes)

The sweater is started at the neckline and worked in one piece from the top to the bottom. Using the smaller dpns, cast on 96 [96 - 104] sts and close the round being careful not to twist the sts. Knit 2 rnds in stockinette, 3 rnds in ribbing then switch to larger dpns and cont. working in stockinette st.

Rnd 8: knit and place marker at every 8th st (= 12 [12 - 13] marked sts)

Rnd 9: M1 before and after each marked st (= k1tbl using the horizontal bar between the sts) (= 120 [120 - 130] sts). Make these incs before and after the marked sts in every foll 5th rnd 7 [8 - 8] times more (= 55 [58 - 60] sts). Change to the 5 - 6 mm circular needles when the sts become crowded on the dpns.

When work meas 23 [24 - 25] cm (= 55 [58 - 60] rnds divide the work as foll. (the beg of the rnd is between the back and the right sleeve):

61 [65 - 70] sts right sleeve, 83 [91 - 99] sts front, 61 [65 - 70] sts left sleeve, 83 [91 - 99] sts back. Place the sts for each sleeve onto a holder.

#### Front and Back:

Place all the sts for the front and the back

(166 [182 - 198] sts) onto the circular needle and cast on 8 new sts between the front and back on each side (= 182 [198 - 214] sts). Cont even in stockinette st in rnds 28 [30 - 32] cm (= 67 [72 - 77] rnds). Then change to the smaller circular needles (4,5 - 5-5 mm) and work 4 cm (= 10 rnds) in ribbing. Then cast off all sts even in patt.

#### Sleeves:

Transfer the 61 [65 - 70] sts for one sleeve onto 4 dpns (5 - 6 mm) and cast on 8 new sts (under-arm) (= 69 [73 - 78] sts) and close the rnd. Work in stockinette st.

Rnd 10: for the sleeve shaping over the newly cast on sts work the 3rd and 4th st tog (k2tog) and place marker over this st (= 68 [72 - 77] sts). Then in every foll 4th rnd 14 [16 - 16] times skp before the marker and k2tog after the marker (= 40 [40 - 45] sts). When sleeve meas 36 [38 - 40] cm (= 86 [91 - 96] rnds) change to smaller needles (4,5 - 5,5 mm) and work 4 cm (= 10 rnds) in ribbing patt. Next rnd: cast off all sts even in patt.

Work 2nd sleeve alike.

#### Finishing:

Close the small underarm holes. Weave in ends.
