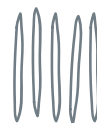
MERINO PURE

Ribbed Hat

Difficulty level:



Needles:



3,0 – 4,0

Quality:

Merino Pure from Gründl
100 % Virgin Wool (Merino
extrafine superwash)
50 g / 120 m

Size:

Head Circumference approx.
51 cm - 54 cm

Usage:

approx. 100 g in col. 20 (bright
blue)

Tension:

26 sts and 32 rnds to 10 cm measured over ribbing, slightly stretched

Stitch Pattern:

Ribbing in rounds: (amount of sts multiple of 2)
Alt k1, p1 throughout.

Instructions:

The hat is working in the round. Using the dpns, cast on 112 sts and close the round being careful not to twist the sts. Divide evenly amongst the 4 needles (4 x 28 sts). Work 24 cm (= 77 rnds) in ribbing pattern. In the next rnd mark every 14th st with a stitch marker or yarn remnant and work each marked st with the st before as k2tog (= 104 sts). Work the remaining sts in pattern as established. Next rnd: work the sts in pattern. Work the decs as established in every alt rnd 10 times more (= 24 sts). Next rnd: k2tog to end of rnd (= 12 sts)

Cut yarn and thread through the remaining 12 sts and pull together to close the hole. Weave in the ends. Turn back cuff approx. 8 - 9 cm.
