HAPPY KIDDY

Child's pullover with horizontal stripes

Difficulty level:



Needles:



4 - 5

Quality:

Happy Kiddy (Fa. Gründl)
100 % Acrylic (antipilling)
100 g / 250 m

Size:

80/86 (92/98 - 104/110)

Usage:

approx. 200 (300-300) g

Pattern:

Garter stitch: RS and WS rows: k all sts.

Stocking stitch: RS row.: k all sts, WS row: p all sts.

Horizontal ribs:

Row 1: (RS): k all sts.

Row 2: (WS): p all sts.

Row 3-4: k all sts.

Rep these 4 rows cont.

Tip for multicoloured yarn:

To achieve an harmonious striped effect, when starting a new piece or ball of yarn, pay attention to start your knitting at the same point of the striped colour repeat. Begin **all** balls for your project either from the outside or the inside.

Selvedge stitches: at beg of row: sl 1 k-wise; at end of row: k 1.

Tension: 21 sts x 29 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm over stocking stitch

21 sts x 36 rows = 10 x 10 cm over horizontal rib patt.

Instructions: (changes for larger size in parenthesis)

Back:

Cast on 63 (74-84) sts + 2 selvedge sts
(= 65 (76 - 86) sts total)

Rows 1-3 (beg with WS row) k all sts.

Next row: cont work in horizontal stripe patt.

Work until piece meas. 20 (22 - 24) cm (= row 73 (79 - 87)) and place a marker on each side for the sleeve placement.

When work meas. 32 (36 - 40) cm (= row 117 (131 - 145)) for the **back neck opening:**

Next row (RS) selvedge st, work 20 (24 - 28) sts in horizontal rib patt and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work on this set of 21 (25 - 29) sts only for right side of neck.

Next row(WS): cast off 3 (4 - 4) sts and on foll WS row cast off 3 (3 - 4) sts = 15 (18 - 21) sts.

Work straight in patt until work meas. 34 (38 - 42) cm (= row 123 (137 - 151)) then bind off all sts.

Return to sts on holder and cast off centre 23 (26 – 28) sts and work row to end.
 Next row (WS): work to end in established patt.
 Next row (RS): cast off 3 (4 – 4) sts and on foll WS row cast off 3 (3 – 4) sts.
 Work straight in patt until work meas. 34 (38 – 42) cm (= row 123 (137 – 151)) then bind off rem shoulder sts loosely.

Front:

Work as given for Back until work meas. 29 (33 – 37) cm (= row 105 (119 – 133)) for the **front neck opening:**
 Next row (RS) selvedge st, work 25 (29 – 33) sts in horizontal rib patt and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.
 Work on this set of 26 (30 – 34) sts only for right side of neck.
 Next row(WS): and on foll WS rows cast off 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st three times (4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st three times – 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice) = 15 (18 – 21) sts.
 Work straight in patt until work meas. 34 (38 – 42) cm (= row 123 (137 – 151)) then bind off all sts.
 Return to sts on holder and cast off centre 13 (16 – 18) sts and work row to end.
 Next row (WS): work to end in established patt.
 Next row(RS): and on foll RS rows cast off 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st three times (4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st three times – 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice) = 15 (18 – 21) sts.
 Work straight in patt until work meas. 34 (38 – 42) cm (= row 123 (137 – 151)) then bind off rem shoulder sts loosely.

Sleeves:

Cast on 38 (42 – 42) sts plus 2 selvedge sts (= 40 (44–44) sts total).
 Rows 1–3 (beg with WS row) k all sts.
 Rows 4–15: cont in horizontal rib patt.
 Next row: cont work in stocking st working sleeve shaping at the same time.
 Row 8: inc 1 st on both sides of work = 42 (46–46) sts (including selvedge sts).
 Rep these inc every 4th and alt. 6th row 9 (11 – 15) times = (= 60 (68 – 76) sts).
 When work meas. 21 (25 – 30) cm (= 61 (73 – 89) rows) bind off all sts loosely.

Making up:

Join one shoulder seam. For the neckband along the neck edge with right side facing,

pick up and knit 84 (92–100) sts and work 5 rows in garter st. patt. (1st row is a WS row) then bind off all sts loosely. Join the second shoulder seam. Sew in sleeves. Join arm and side seams.
