Scarf with 2-Colour Brioche Pattern

Ecolana from Gründl
100 % Virgin Wool (kbT)
50 g / 100 m

Size:

Width: approx. 25 cm,
Length: approx. 180 cm

Usage:

approx. 200 g in col. 13 (heather grey), approx. 200 g in col. 14 (heather slate)

Pattern:

2 Colour brioche with double selvedge sts:
(amount of sts multiple of 2 plus 4 selvedge sts)
! Always work 2 WS rows (one in col. 13 and 1 in col. 14) and then 2 RS rows (one in col. 13 and one in col. 14)!

Double selvedge sts: k2 at beg of row pulling the yarn snug to make sure the first st isn't too loose and sl 2 p-wise wyif at end of row
Row 1 (WS row in col. 13): 2 selvedge sts, * sl1yo, k1, rep from * and end row with 2 selvedge sts. Slide all the sts back to the beg of the circular needle (do not turn)!

Row 2 (WS row in col. 14): 2 selvedge sts, * 1 brk, sl1yo, rep from * and end row with 2 selvedge sts. Turn work.

Row 3 (RS row in col. 13): 2 selvedge sts, * 1 brk, sl1yo, rep from * and end row with 2 selvedge sts.

Slide all the sts back to the beg of the circular needle (do not turn)!

Row 4 (RS row in col. 14): 2 selvedge sts, * sl1yo, 1 brk, rep from * and end row with 2 selvedge sts. Turn work.

Row 5 (WS row in col. 13): 2 selvedge sts, * sl1yo, 1 brk, rep from * and end row with 2 selvedge sts. Slide all the sts back to the beg of the circular needle (do not turn)!

Rows 2 - 5 establish the pattern. Rep these 4 rows cont throughout.

One colour brioche with double selvedge sts:
(amount of sts multiple of 2 + 4 selvedge sts)
RS and WS: 2 selvedge sts, * sl1yo, 1 brk, rep from * and end row with 2 selvedge sts. Rep RS and WS rows throughout.

Tension:

15 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm meas over brioche st using size 4 - 5 mm circular needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

Instructions:

Using col. 13 cast on 40 sts (including 2 selvedge sts for each edge) and work in 2 colour brioche

pattern with double selvedge sts. Cont until 1 ball of each colour is used. Begin with col. 13 and end with row 3 in col. 13. Then cont in one colour brioche using col. 14 until 2 balls have been worked ending with a WS row. Then work the 2 colour brioche again beg with the 2nd row (= WS row in col. 13, and **replace col. 13 with col. 14 and col. 14 with col. 13.** (This will reverse the dominant colour on the side facing). Then cont in one colour brioche until almost 2 balls in col. 13 are worked. Then cast off all sts even working the sl1yo as brk and purl the p sts. k2tog the selvedge sts. Weave in ends.
