Pillow size 30 cm x 50 cm

Usage:

Pillow 1:

approx. 100 g in col. 07 (light grey-dark grey), approx. 150 g in col. 06 (grey) and approx. 100 g in col. 08 (dark grey) ; Pillow 2:
approx. 50 g in col. 05 (light grey), approx. 150 g in col. 01 (natural-light grey), approx. 50 g in col. 02 (natural) and approx. 100 g in col. 04 (beige)

Stitch Pattern:

Dc in spiral rnds:

The dc are worked cont over the beg of the rnds. Mark the first st in each rnd with a contrast piece of yarn or a stitch marker.

Back post treble in spiral rnds: (work loosely)

Rnd 1: dc all sts

Rnd 2: dc around the dc of the previous rnd.

Do not end each rnd individually, but cont working over the beg of the rnds.

Mark the first st in each rnd with a contrast piece of yarn or a stitch marker.

When changing colours, begin at the marked st and pull the last loop of the last st through using the new colour.

Work rnds 1-2 cont throughout.

Colour Sequence:

Pillow 1: (total of 70 rnds.) 21 rnds in col. 07, 28 rnds in col. 06 and 21 rnds in col. 08

Pillow 2: (total of 70 rnds.) 12 rnds in col. 05, 26 rnds in col. 01, 12 rnds in col. 02 and 20 rnds in col. 04

Tension:

13 sts and 15 rnds to 10 cm worked in double crochet in spiral rnds.

13 sts and 13 rnds to 10 cm worked in back post treble in spiral rnds.

Instructions:

Using the first colour in the color sequence cast on 80 ch and close the rnd. Cont. in the given colour sequence and the following pattern:

15 rnds dc in spiral rnds (= 10 cm)

40 rnds in bptc in spiral rnds (= 30 cm)

15 rnds of dc in spiral rnds (= 10 cm)

When work measures total of 50 cm close the last rnd with 1 sl st.

Lay the pillowcase flat together (beg of rnd is the side edge) and close the opening of 40 dcs on each side with sl sts, placing the needle only into the back post. Insert pillow and close the cast on with sl sts, placing the needle only into the back post as before. Weave in loose ends. Knot in fringes as desired.

beg = begin(ning)

bptc = back post treble crochet

ch = chain

cont = continue (continuously)

dc = double crochet

rnd(s) = round(s)

sl st = slip stitch
