SYLT

Hat with Triangle Pattern

Difficulty level:



Needles:



6 – 7 mm

Quality:

Sylt from Gründl 80 % Polyacrylic, 20 % Wool 100 g / 130 m







x or 1x or 1

Size:

Head circumference approx. 52 – 56 cm

Usage: approx. 100 g in col. 13 (honey yellow) or col. 04 (anise), or col. 06 (chestnut)

Stitch Pattern:

Stockinette stitch in rnds: knit all sts Garter stitch in rnds: alt 1 rnd purl and 1 rnd knit sts

<u>Triangle pattern:</u> (amount of sts multiple of 12) (refer to chart) only every 2nd rnd is shown. Work the alt rnds in knit sts.

Tension: (kraus rechts)

13 sts and 25 rnds. to 10 cm meas over garter st using size 6–7 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

Pattern:

Using the dpns, cast on 60 and divide evenly among the needles (= 4×15 sts) and close rnd being careful not to twist the sts. Work 12 rnds in garter st. Then cont in triangle patt working the 12 st rep 5 times in the rnd. When hat meas total of 20 cm (= 49 rnds (= 12 rnds in garter st, 1st - 24th rnd of chart then 1st - 13th rnd of chart)) work the decs as foll:

Rnd 50: work until 2 sts before garter st then k2tog tbl, k1 (garter st), k2tog tbl. Work these decs in every patt rep (= 50 st).

Work the decs in the foll rnd links as established in patt.

Work the rnds between the decs as established in chart.

Rnd 54: work until 2 sts before the 5 garter st then k2tog tbl, k5 (garter st), k2tog tbl. Work these decs in every patt rep (= 40 st). Work the decs in the foll rnd links as established in patt.

Rnd 58: work every 3rd and 4th st as k2tog (= 30 sts)

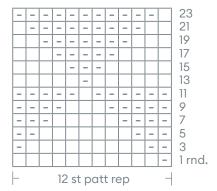
Rnd 62: work every 2nd and 3rd st as k2tog (= 20 sts)

Rnd 64: k2tog throughout (= 10 sts)
Cut yarn with long tail and pull through rem
10 sts twice. Pull yarn to close hole. Sew pompom onto the top of the hat. Weave in ends.
