Garter Stitch Cap

Pretty from Gründl
100 % Polyacrylic
100 g / 166 m

Size:

head circumference
approx. 53 cm - 56 cm

Usage:

approx. 50 g each in colours 13 (wine red), col.14 (amber), col. 09 (violet), col. 15 (moss green) and col. 10 (petrol)

Stitch Pattern:

Garter Stitch Pattern: k all sts in RS and WS rows.

Selvedge St: first st at beg of row sl 1 k-wise and last st: k1

Tension: 16 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm meas over garter stitch pattern.

Pattern:

Using col. 13 (wine red) cast on 74 sts (including selvedge sts) and beg with a WS row work in garter st patt. When cap meas 4,5 cm (= 15 rows) cont. in garter st in following col. sequence: 14 rnds each in col. 14 (amber), col. 09 (violet) and col. 15 (moss green) then work 2 rnds in col 10 (petrol) placing a marker (contrast thread) at every 8th st for the decs. Finish the cap using col. 10 (petrol).

Next row (RS): * work to 1 st before marker and k2tog, rep from * cont. to end of row. (= 63 sts)
Work these decs over the marked sts every RS row until only 11 sts rem on the needle.

Cut the yarn and thread through the rem 11 sts twice. Pull sts taut to close the hole. Close the back seam using a flat seam st such as mattress st. Weave in ends.
