Size:

Height (sitting) approx. 22 cm
(without ears)

Usage:

approx. 100 g each in col. 19
(beige) and in col. 05 (cream)

Additionally you will also need: 1 pair of safety eyes or sew on eyes in size ø 10 mm, remnants of cotton yarn in pink (e.g. Cotton Quick uni in col. 128) and anthracite (e.g. Cotton Quick uni in col. 110) to stitch on the nose, facial features and claws; remnants of cotton yarn in white (e.g. Cotton Quick uni in col. 01) to accent the eyes; approx. 80 g of polyester filling, matching sewing thread in beige or cream, for the carrot you will additionally need remnants in green (e.g. Cotton Quick uni in col. 140) and orange (e.g. Cotton Quick uni in col. 146) and a flower button in pink (e.g. Gründl article number 1447-3)

Stitch Pattern:

Dc in Spiral Rounds: The dcs are worked continuously in spiral rnds starting the new rnd directly after the previous rnd without a slip stitch. Mark the first st of each new rnd with a stitch marker or a contrast piece of yarn. This helps when counting rnds.

Tip: When changing colours, work only half of the st in the first col then work the last loop in the new col.

To make sure the change of rnds is on the back and on the bottom of the arms and legs, occasionally add a stitch in the col last used and mark as the new start of a rnd. (this will not add sts to the amount of sts but move the start of the new rnd)

Dc in rows: (ears) every row of dcs beg with 1 tch as a replacement for the first dc and ends with 1 dc in the tch of the previous row.

Tension:

15 sts and 13 rows/rnds to 10 cm meas over double crochet using size 4 - 5 mm needles. A tension swatch should be made before beginning work. Double check this with the tension given and change needle size if needed. Only then will the measurements (cm), rows, sts and usage be correct.

Instructions:

Caution: To be used only as decoration - this is not a toy!

Tip: All of the pieces for the bunny should be crocheted tightly, this means to double check your tension to assure the filling stays inside the finished pieces. The individual pieces should be sewn together tightly and all loose threads carefully secured.

Body: (beg at bottom)

Using col. beige make a magic ring and dc6 into the ring (= rnd 1). Cont dcs in spiral rnds in beige and starting with rnd 11 cont in the col given:

Rnd 2: double each st (= work 2 dc into each st) (= 12 sts)

Rnd 3: double every 2nd st (= 18 sts)

Rnd 4: double every 3rd st (= 24 sts)

Rnd 5: double every 4th st (= 30 sts)

Rnd 6: double every 5th st (= 36 sts)

Rnd 7: double every 6th st (= 42 sts)

Rnds 8 - 10: work even (dc without inc or dec)

Rnd 11: (in col. cream) dc10, dc2tog, * dc2, dc2tog, rep from * 4 times more then dc to end of rnd (= 36 sts)

Rnd 12: (in col. cream) work even

Rnd 13: (in col. beige) dc10, dc2tog, * dc1, dc2tog, rep from * 4 times more then dc to end of rnd (= 30 sts)

Rnds 14 - 15: (in col. cream) work even

Rnd 16: (in col. beige)* dc3, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 24 sts)

Rnd 17: (in col. cream) work even

Rnd 18: (in col. cream)* dc2, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 18 sts)

Rnd 19: (in col. beige) work even

Now add filling and cont as you work

Rnd 20: (in col. beige)* dc1, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 12 sts)

Rnd 21: (in col. beige) work even

Place more filling into the belly.

Rnd 22: (in col. beige)* dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 6 sts)

Cut yarn and pull through last st. Close the opening.

Head: (beg at the front of the snout in col. beige)

Rnds 1 - 7: work as in rnds 1-7 for the body (= 42 sts)

Rnd 8: double every 7th st (= 48 sts)

Rnds 9 - 11: work even

Rnd 12: (in col. beige)* dc6, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 42 sts)

Rnd 13: (in col. beige)* dc5, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 36 sts)

Rnd 14: (in col. beige)* dc4, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 30 sts)

Rnd 15: (in col. beige)* dc3, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 24 sts)

Rnd 16: (in col. beige)* dc2, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 18 sts)

Now beg stuffing the filling into the head.

Rnd 17: (in col. beige)* dc1, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 12 sts)

Finish stuffing the head.

Rnd 18: * dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 6 sts)

Cut yarn and pull through last st. Close the opening.

Legs: (make 2 alike)

Start with col. cream:

Rnds 1 - 4: work as in rnds 1-4 for the body (= 24 sts)

Rnds 5 - 6: work even

Rnd 7: dc6, * dc2tog, rep from * 5 times more then dc6 (= 18 sts)

Rnd 8: dc5, * dc2tog, rep from * 3 times more then dc5 (= 14 sts)

Rnds 9 - 10: work even

Rnd 11: (in col. beige)* dc5, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 12 sts)

Rnd 12: (in col. beige)* dc4, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 10 sts)

Now firmly stuff the filling into the foot and stuff only a small amount into the leg.

Rnds 13 - 19: work even

Cut yarn and pull through last st. Close the opening.

Arms: (work 2 alike, beg in col beige and work in both col as given)

Using col. beige make a magic ring and dc6 into the ring (= rnd 1). Cont dcs in spiral rnds in beige and starting with rnd 10 cont in beige as given:

Rnd 2: double each st (= work 2 dc into each st) (= 12 sts)

Rnd 3: double every 4th st (= 15 sts)

Rnd 4: work even

Rnd 5: * dc3, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 12 sts)

Rnd 6: * dc2, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 9 sts)

Rnds 7 - 9: work even (dc without inc or dec)

Rnds 10 - 20: work even while changing col: 2 rnds in cream and 1 rnd in beige

Rnd 21: work even in cream

Cut yarn and pull through last st. Close the opening.

Inner Ear: (work 2 alike in cream)

Cast on 13 ch and 1 tch (counts as 1st dc) and work both sides of the chain in back and forth rows as follows:

dc1 into the 3rd ch from the needle, then in the foll 10 ch work 10 dc, dc3 into last ch then work on the other side of the chain dc12 (= row 1) (= 27 sts)

Row 2: tch1 and turn work, dc11 (one st into each dc of prev row), double next 3 sts (= work 2 dc into each st), dc12 (= 30 sts)

Cut yarn and pull through last st.

Outer Ear: (work 2 alike in beige)

Work the 1st and 2nd row as given for the inner ear.

Row 3: tch1, dc12, double next 3 sts, dc14 (= 33 sts)

Tail:

Using col. cream make a magic ring and dc6 into the ring (= rnd 1). Cont. dcs in spiral rnds.

Rnd 2: double every st (= 2 dc in every st of the previous rnd)(= 12 sts)

Rnd 3: work even

Rnd 4: dc2tog to end (= 6 sts)

Cut yarn and pull through last st.

Stuff filling into tail. Close the opening.

Flower:

Using the cotton yarn remnants in pink make a magic ring and ch9 and dc1 into the ring (flower petal), then cont around the ring with 5 more petals * ch8, dc1, rep from * 4 times more. Cut yarn and pull through last st.

Then for the leaves with the cotton yarn remnants in green make a magic ring and ch12 and dc 1 into the ring (= 1 leaf) then * ch13 and dc1 (= 2nd leaf). Cut yarn and pull through last st.

Place a wooden flower shaped button on top of the flower and sew both onto the leaves.

Carrot: (start at the top)

Using the cotton yarn remnant in orange make a magic ring and dc6 into the ring (= rnd 1). Cont dcs in spiral rnds.

Rnd 2: double each st (= work 2 dc into each st) (= 12 sts)

Rnd 3: double every 2nd st (= 18 sts)

Rnds 4 - 11: work even

Rnd 12: * dc4, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 15 sts)

Rnd 13: work even

Rnd 14: * dc3, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 12 sts)

Rnd 15: * work even

Now beg stuffing the filling into the carrot.

Rnd 16: * dc2, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 9 sts)

Rnds 17 - 18: work even

Finish stuffing the filling into the carrot.

Rnd 19: * dc1, dc2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (= 6 sts)

Rnds 20 - 21: work even

Rnd 22: dc2tog to end (= 3 sts)

Cut yarn and pull through last st. Close the opening.

Using the cotton yarn remnant in green cast on 6ch and work 6 sl st into the 6ch. Then, once again, * ch5 and work 5 sl sts into the 5 ch, rep from * 3 times more. Cut yarn and pull through last st. Sew together at bottom and attach to top of carrot.

Finishing:

Using remnants of cotton yarn in anthracite stitch 3 claws onto the legs (see image as reference). Sew the arms and legs to the body. Embroider the nose onto the face using remnants of cotton yarn in pink, making horizontal stitches close to another approx 1,5 cm long on the front of the head approx. between the 2nd and 3rd rnd of the head. Sew the inner ear onto the outer ear using matching sewing thread. Then ford the ear together and sew together only 2 cm along the bottom edge. Attach the ears to the top of the head. Sew on eyes (if safety eyes were not used) and when doing so pull the yarn tightly through the head and

knot on the bottom. This will give the face more shape and character. Using the cotton yarn remnants in white, embroider a few stitches on the right and left sides of the eyes to add highlights. Embroider the remaining facial features (eyebrows and the line below the nose) using col anthracite.

Tip: Pull the ends of the yarn after sewing and stitching to the inside and to the bottom of the head. Knot and secure the ends. They will not be visible when finished.

Now sew the head to the body. Sew the tail to the back. As desired sew the flower to the top of the head next to the ears.

Tip: You can also make your bunny a little blanket or a cuddle cloth out of leftover yarn.
