

Instructions

COLOURFUL Crocheted Triangle Shawl

Difficulty:



Needles:



7 – 8 mm

Quality:

Colourful from Gründl
65 % Virgin Wool (superwash),
35 % Polyacrylic
200 g / 510 m

Size:

Upper edge: approx. 150 cm,
Side length: approx. 100 cm

Usage: approx. 200 g

Stitch Pattern: (refer to crochet chart)

Treble.:

Every RS row begins with 2ch as rep for the first tr and ends with 1 tr worked into the 3rd ch in the beg of the previous row. Every WS row begins with 3 ch as rep for the first tr and ends with 1 tr worked into the 2nd ch at the beg of the previous row.

Treble group:

Work 3tr into one st. The tr groups are always worked between the ch or tr/ tr group of the prev row.

Tension: 12 sts (= 4 × 3 tr) x 7 rows to 10 cm meas over pattern.

Instructions:

Work the shawl as shown in crochet chart.
Cast on 3 ch.

Row 1: (= RS row) ch2 (rep for the 1st tr), tr3 into the 2nd ch, tr1 into the 3rd tr.

Row 2: ch3 (rep for the 1st tr), tr3 between the last tr and the group of tr in the prev row, tr1 into the 2nd ch of the prev row.

Cont work as shown in crochet chart and cont working the incs along the left hand edge as given, this creates 1 additional group of tr in every 2nd row.

Cont working until the entire skein is used. Pull yarn through last st. Weave in ends. Wet shawl and wet block to measurements,
