POLLY POMPON

Hat with Textured Pattern and Fur Pompon

Difficulty level:



Needles:



6 - 7

Quality:

Polly Pompon from Gründl
50 % Polyacrylic,
25 % Wool, 25 % Polyester
100 g / 140 m

Size:

head circumference approx.
52 cm - 56 cm

Usage:

approx. 100g

Stitch Pattern:

Ribbing: (in rnds., amount of sts multiple of 2)
alt k1, p1 throughout

Textured pattern: (in rnds., amount of sts
multiple of 2)

Rnd 1 + 2: k all sts

Rnd 3 + 4: alt k1, p1

Rnd 5 + 6: k all sts

Rnd 7 + 8: alt p1, k1

These 8 rnds establish the pattern. Rep these
rnds throughout.

Tension:

14 sts and 22 rnds to 10 cm measured over
textured pattern using size 6-7mm needles or
size needed to achieve given tension.

Instructions:

The hat is worked in the rnd.

Using the dpns cast on 60 sts and divide evenly
amongst the 4 needles (4 x 15 sts) and close the
rnd being careful not to twist the sts. Work
4 cm in ribbing (= 8 rnds). Then cont. in textured
pattern for 15 cm (= 34 rnds). Then make decs as
follows:

Rnd 35: *p1, k1, p1, sk2p, rep from * cont. to end
of rnd. (= 40 sts)

Rnd 36: alt p1, k1

Rnd 37 + 38: k all sts

Rnd 39: * p1, sk2p, rep from * to end of rnd.
(= 20 sts)

Rnd 40: alt p1, k1

Rnd 41: k2tog throughout to end of rnd. (= 10 sts)

Cut thread and pull through remaining sts. Pull
taught to close hole. Attach pompon to top of
hat. Weave in ends.
