

# Pattern COTTON QUICK FLOW

### **Sweater with Eyelet Pattern and Bell Sleeves**

#### Difficulty level:

#### Quality:

Cotton Quick Flow from Gründl 100 % cotton (mercerised, gassed, combed) 100 g / 250 m

#### Size:

EU women's size 36/38 (40/42) **Usage:** approx. 600 (700) g in col. 03 (petrol)

#### Stitch Pattern:

Stockinette:

RS rows: knit, WS rows: purl Garter Stitch Pattern:

RS and WS rows: knit Eyelet Pattern: (amount of sts multiple of 4 plus

2 plus 2 selvedge sts)

Row 1 (= RS): 1 selvedge st, \*p2, 1yo, skp, rep from \* cont and end row with p2,

1 selvedge st.

Row 2 (= WS): 1 selvedge st, \*k2, 1yo, skp, rep from \* cont and end row with k1,

1 selvedge st.

Row 3: 1 selvedge st, \*p2, 1yo, skp, rep from \* cont and end row with p2, 1 selvedge st.

Rows 2-3 establish the pattern. Rep these 2 rows cont throughout.

Slip garter stitch selvedge:

At beg of row sl1 k-wise and k1 at end of each row

#### Tension:

24 sts and 33 rows to 10 cm meas over <u>stockinette</u> st

24 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm meas over <u>eyelet</u> pattern

**Instructions:** (changes for the larger size are shown in brackets. If only one number is shown this applies to both sizes)

The sweater is worked in one piece starting at the bottom edge of the front, then new sts are cast on for the sleeves, then continued over the boatneck and shoulders and then the back, as well as the sleeves, are worked from the top to the bottom

Cast on 128 [138] sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and starting with a WS row work in stockinette st for 46 [48] cm (= 151 [159] rows). Then for the attached sleeves in every foll alt row cast on 1 st each side 4 times, 2 sts 4 times and 88 [92] sts each side once (= 328 [346] sts). Then cont in eyelet pattern, working the first 2 sts after the


selvedge st and the last 2 sts at the end of the row before the selvedge st in garter st. Work even for 17 [19] cm (= 58 [64] rows) then for the boatneck cast off the centre 72 [80] sts loosely and in the foll row cast on 72 [80] sts over the opening. Work 17 [19] cm (= 58 [64] rows) more in eyelet patt as established then cont in stockinette and cast off both sides 88 [92] sts, then in every foll alt row 2 sts 4 times and 1 st 4 times (= 128 [138] sts). Work 46 [48] cm (= 151 [159] rows even then cast off all sts loosely. Finishing:

Close the side and sleeve seams. Using the crochet hook, work 1 rnd of sl sts around the boatneck opening.
