Baby Cap with Pompom




Needles:

Cuff:

Quality:

Baby Cotton from Gründl
50 % Cotton,
50 % Polyacrylic
50 g / 140 m

Size:

Head Circumference:
approx. 38 cm - 41 cm

Usage:

approx. 50 g each in Baby Cotton
col. 13 (petrol) and in col. 02 (light
grey), 1 pompom Panda from
Gründl in col. 52 (camel)

Tension:

Cuff: (using needle size 2,5 - 3 mm) 30 sts and
41 rnds. to 10 cm meas over ribbing pattern.

Cap: (using needle size 3 - 3,5 mm) 27 sts and
40 rnds. to 10 cm meas over stockinette stitch.

Stitch Pattern:

Ribbing Pattern: (amount of sts multiple of 2)

in rnds: alt k1, p1

Stockinette Stitch:

in rnds: knit all sts.

Colour Sequence:

approx. 6 cm (= 24 rnds) in ribbing patt in col.
petrol, then in stockinette 2 cm (= 8 rnds) each
in col. petrol, col. light grey, col. petrol, col. light
grey and then finish the cap in col. petrol.

Instructions:

The cap is worked in rnds.

Using col. petrol and the smaller dpns, cast on
100 sts and divide the sts amongst the 4 work-
ing needles. Close the rnd being careful not to
twist the sts. Work in ribbing for 6 cm (= 24 rnds).
Then change to the larger needles and work the
rest of the cap in stockinette st in rnds in the
given colour sequence.

Make the decreases for the top when work
meas total of 16 cm (= 64 rnd): place a marker at
every 10th st then k2tog the marked sts and the
st before the marker (= 90 sts). Continue these
decs over the marked sts in every alt rnd until
only 10 sts remain. Then cut the yarn leaving
a tail and thread through the remaining sts. Pull
together to close the hole. Secure ends. Sew the
pompom onto the top of the cap. Fold half of
the cuff back as shown.
