Stitch Pattern:

Vest:

Ribbing Pattern: (amount of sts multiple of 2 plus 1 st)

WS rows: selvedge st, alt k1, p1 and end with k1, selvedge st.

RS rows: work the sts between the selvedge sts as they appear (k the knit sts and p the purl sts)

Half-Brioche Pattern: (amount of sts multiple of 2 plus 1 st)

WS rows: * k1, sl1yo, rep from * cont and end with k1
RS rows: * p1, brk, rep from * cont and end with p1

Slipped Selvedge Stitch: sl1 k-wise at beg of row and k1 at end of row

Double Selvedge Stitch: (on sleeve and v-neckline)
k2 at beg of row and at end of row sl2 p-wise wyif

Cap: (in rnds)

Stockinette Stitch: knit all sts

Ribbing (Cuff): (amount of sts multiple of 2)
alt p1, k1 throughout

Tension:

Vest: 22 sts and 44 rows to 10 cm over half brioche stitch pattern

Cap: 23 sts and 32 rnds to 10 cm over stockinette stitch

Instructions:

Vest: (changes for larger size given in brackets. If only one number is shown this applies to both sizes)

Back:

Cast on 65 [73] sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and work 3 cm (= 10 rows) in ribbing patt with 1 slipped selvedge st on each edge. Beg work with a WS row. Then work 14 [17] cm (= 62 [74] rows) in half-brioche patt between the selvedge sts. Then work the armholes on both edges: cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows and cont in half-brioche patt with 2 selvedge sts along each edge (= 55 [63] sts plus 4 selvedge sts = 59 [67] sts total). Then dec 1 st each side in every foll 4th row 3 times (= at beg of

row after the double selvedge p2tog and at end of row p2tog the 2 sts before the double selvedge sts. In the row after the dec work the dec st as a knit st (= 53 [61] sts). When work measures 27 [32] cm (= 118 [140] rows) in half-brioche patt cast off all sts even in patt working the double selvedge sts k2tog.

Front:

Work same as for the back until piece measures 17 [20] cm (= 76 [88] rows) above border ending with a WS row. For the neck shaping, place marker on the centre st and in the foll (RS) row p1 and p1 tbl into the marked st. In the next row (WS) divide work evenly and bind off from neck edge, starting with the left side (when wearing): double selvedge sts, 23 [27] sts in half-brioche patt, 2 double selvedge sts. Next row (WS): double selvedge sts, k2tog, work rem sts in patt, 2 selvedge sts. In the next RS row purl the dec. Work these decs for the v-neckline in every foll 4th row 10 [12] times more. When same length as back (27 [32] cm (= 118 [140] rows) above border cast off rem 16 [18] sts in patt for shoulder, working the double selvedge sts as k2tog. For the right neckline edge the same, reversing shaping working the decs in the WS rows over the 2 sts before the double selvedge sts.

Finishing:

Sew shoulder and side seams. Weave in ends.

Cap: (changes for larger size given in brackets. If only one number is shown this applies to both sizes)

The cap is worked in rnds.

With 2.5 - 3 mm dpns cast on 90 [99] sts and divide evenly amongst 4 needles. Close the rnd being careful not to twist the sts. Place marker at beg of rnd. Work 3 cm (= 10 rnds) in ribbing patt.

Change to larger dpns (3 - 3.5 mm) and cont work 12 cm (= 38 rnds) in stockinette st. Place marker at every 10th [11th] st and in next rnd k2tog the marked st and the st before marker (= 81 [90] sts). Work decs in this manner every alt rnd until only 9 sts remain. Next rnd: k2tog every 2nd and 3rd st. Then cont even for the pointed tip cont over the rem 6 sts 10 - 12 rnds. (or work in i-cord technique over 2 needles in rows: k6, push all 6 sts to the beg of the needle, pull yarn tightly and k6 again (do not turn work), cont until the desired height is reached). In the last rnd (or row) k2tog to end and then cut yarn leaving a tail.

Thread yarn through rem 3 sts and pull together to close hole. Weave in ends.
