## Usage:

approx. 50 g each in colours 13 (wine red), col. 14 (amber), col. 09 (violet), col. 15 (moss green) and col. 10 (petrol)

Stitch Pattern: (in rnds.) (amount of sts multiple of 2)
Ribbing: alt k1, pl
Reverse Stockinette St: p all sts in each rnd.
Colour Sequence: * 2 rnds each in col. 14, col.
09, col. 15, col. 14, col. 10, col. 13, rep from * cont.

## Tension:

16 sts and 24 rnds to 10 cm meas over rev stockinette st

## Instructions:

The cap is worked in the round.
Using col. 13 (wine red) and the smaller set of dpns cast on 72 sts and close the rnd being careful not to twist the sts. Divide the sts evenly amongst the 4 needles ( $=4 \times 18$ sts) and work 4 cm (= 9 rnds) in ribbing pattern. Then work 1 rnd of purl sts. Change to larger needles and cont in rev stockinette st pattern following the colour sequence as given for $17,5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ( $=42$ rnds). Finish the cap using col. 14 (amber).
Work the decs in every other rnd as given, working rev stockinette st in the alt rnds: Rnd 43: p2tog every 7th and 8th st (= 63 sts) Rnd 45: p2tog every 6th and 7th st (= 54 sts) Rnd 47: p2tog every 5th and 6th st (= 45 sts ) Rnd 49: p2tog every 4th and 5th st (= 36 sts ) Rnd 51: p2tog every 3rd and 4th st (= 27 sts) Rnd 53: p2tog every 2nd and 3rd st (= 18 sts ) Rnd 55: p2tog throughout (= 9 sts)
Cut the yarn and thread through the rem 9 sts wice and pull taut to close the hole. Weave in ends.
