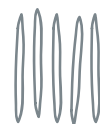
Children's Hat and Snood

Difficulty:



Needles:

Hat:



6 – 7 mm

Snood:



7 – 8 mm

Quality:

Kid & Knit from Gründl
100 % Polyacrylic
200 g / 200 m

Size:

Hat:

Head circumference: approx.
46 cm – 49 cm

Snood:

Circumference: approx. 50 cm,
height: approx. 30 cm

Usage:

approx. 200 g

Tension:

Hat: 13 sts and 22 rnds. to 10 cm meas over seed stitch pattern.

Snood: 12 sts and 20 rnds. to 10 cm meas over seed stitch pattern.

Stitch Pattern:

Ribbing in rnds.: (amount of stitches multiple of 2)
Rnd 1: alt k1, p1. Rep rnd 1 cont throughout.

Seed Stitch in Rnds: (amount of stitches multiple of 2)
Rnd 1: alt p1, k1 throughout.
Rnd. 2: alt k1, p1 throughout.
Rep rnds 1 – 2 cont throughout.

Instructions:

Work hat first, then work the snood with remaining yarn.

Hat:

The hat is worked in rnds.

Using 4 of the smaller dpns cast on 56 sts and divide sts evenly amongst the 4 needles (4 x 14 sts), close the rnd being careful not to twist the sts. Work 4 cm (= 8 rnds) in ribbing pattern. Then continue 10 cm (22 rnds) in seed stitch pattern.

Next rnd (rnd 23): skp every 12th, 13th and 14th st tog on each of the 4 needles (= 48 sts)

Rnd 24: skp every 5th, 6th and 7th sts tog (= 40 sts)

Rnds 25 and 26: work even in seed stitch pattern as established.

Rnd 27: skp every 8th, 9th and 10th sts tog (= 32 sts)

Rnd 28: skp every 3rd, 4th and 5th sts tog (= 24 sts)

Rnds 29 and 30: work even in seed stitch pattern as established.

Rnd 31: skp every 4th, 5th and 6th sts tog (= 16 sts)

Rnd 32: skp every 1st, 2nd and 3rd sts tog (= 8 sts)

Now transfer sts onto 2 dpns (4 on each needle) then place the needles on top of another to join. Slip the sts onto one needle placing one st from back needle then 1 st from front needle and continue until all 8 sts are on one needle. K2tog to end (= 4 sts). For the loop on the top of the hat cont working these rem 4 sts in rows: k4,

slide needle back to start new row and place yarn from the last st behind the sts, pull yarn taut and k4. Cont in this manner until the cord meas 8 cm. Cast off the 4 sts, working the centre 2 sts as k2tog when casting off. Fold cord over and attach cast off edge onto top of hat. Weave in ends.

Snood:

Using larger needles, cast on 60 sts and divide evenly amongst 4 dpns (4 × 15 sts). Close rnd being careful not to twist sts. Work 2.5 cm in ribbing pattern. Then cont in seed stitch patt over next 20 cm (= 40 rnds). Then work 2.5 cm in ribbing pattern. Cast off all sts even in pattern. Weave in ends.
