

Instructions gründ FUNNY DOTS big Cuddly Blanket with Checkerboard

Difficulty level:



Needles:



Quality: Funny Dots big from Gründl 100 % Polyester 150 g / 60 m



5 x

Size: approx. 95 cm x 95 cm Usage: approx. 750 g

Needles:

1 pair of circular needles in size 9 - 10 mm or size needed to achieve given tension.

Stitch Pattern:

<u>Stockinette stitch (SS):</u> RS rows: knit the sts., WS rows: purl the sts. <u>Reverse stockinette stitch (rev SS):</u> RS rows: purl the sts., WS rows.: knit the sts.

<u>Checkerboard pattern:</u> (Amount of sts multiple of 5 plus 2 selvedge sts) *Row 1 (= RS row) - Row 5:*

1 selvedge st, * 5 rev SS sts, 5 SS sts, rep from * 4 times more and end with 5 rev SS sts and 1 selvedge st.

Row 6 (= WS row) - Row 10:

1 selvedge st, * 5 SS sts, 5 rev SS sts, rep from * 4 times more and end with 5 SS sts and 1 selvedge st.

These 10 rows establish the pattern. Rep these rows cont throughout.

<u>Selvedge stitch:</u> sl 1 k-wise at beg of row and k1 at end of row.

Tension:

6 sts and 10 rows to 10 cm meas over checkerboard pattern.

Instructions:

Cast on 57 sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and work straight for 95 cm (= 94 rows) in checkerboard pattern. Then cast off all sts even, working the sts in patt as established.

approx. = approximate(ly) beg = begin(ning) col = colour(s) cont = continue (continuously) foll = follow(s)/ following k = knit k-wise = knit wise meas = measure(d) patt = pattern p = purl rep = repeat rev = reverse RS = right side st(s) = stitch(es) SS = stockinette stitch WS = wrong side
