

Instructions **QUICK & COSY**



Cap with Pompon

Difficulty:



Needles:



8 - 9 mm

Quality:

Quick & Cosy from Gründl 80 % polyacrylic, 20 % wool 150 g / 85 m

Size:

Head circumference approx. 54 cm - 57 cm

Usage:

approx. 150 g (= 1 ball)

Abbreviations:

WS = wrong side

alt = alternate(ing) approx. = approximate(ly) beg = begin(ning) col = colour(s) dec(s) = decrease(s) k = knitmeas = measure(d) p = purl RS = right side tog = together

Needles: one pair of 8 – 9 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension:

Tension:

9 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm measured over textured stitch pattern.

Stitch Pattern:

Cuff Pattern:

RS rows: work the sts as they appear (knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts).

WS rows: alt pl, kl throughout.

Textured Stitch: (amount of sts multiple of 2)

RS rows: knit all sts.

WS rows: alt p1, k1 throughout.

Instructions:

The cap is worked flat in rows (RS and WS rows). Cast on 42 sts (including 1 selvedge st of your choice on each edge). Starting with a WS row, work 5 rows in cuff pattern. Then continue over next 18 rows in textured stitch pattern.

Then work decs for top of cap:

Row 24: (= RS row): k2tog every 7th and 8th st (= 37 sts) Row 25 and next 2 WS rows: Work the sts in pattern as established and purl the decs.


Row 26: k2tog every 6^{th} and 7^{th} st (= 32 sts)

Row 28: k2tog every 5th and 6th st (= 27 sts)

Row 30: k2tog every 4th and 5th st (= 22 sts) Row 31: k2tog throughout to end of row (= 11 sts)

Cut yarn and thread through remaining 11 sts creating a loop. Pull gently to close hole. Close back seam using a flat seam stitch. Weave in ends. Make a pompon in desired size and attach to top of cap.
