

Monster pillowcase

Difficulty level:



Needles:



Quality:

Happy uni (Fa. Gründl) 100 % Acrylic (anti-pilling) 100 g / 250 m



Size:

approx. 39 cm x 39 cm

Usage:

approx. 100 g col. 01 (white), col. 27 (black) und col. 11 (lime green) each = Base colour front of pillow

Pattern:

stocking stitch: 1.row: plain stitches, 2.row: purl stitches

sc in rd (eyes):

each rd. of sc begins with 1 ch as replacement for the 1. sc and ends with 1 slip st. in the replacement ch of the begin of the rd sc in spiral rds (teeth and hair):

The sc are continuously crochet in spirals over the beginning of the rd Mark the 1. st. of each rd with a contrast thread or a stitch marker.

Stitch test (stocking stitch): 21 st. x 27 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Instructions:

Front and back of pillow:

Front and back of pillow are knitted in one piece. Cast on 80 st. plus 2 edge stitches in the base colour of the front of the pillow, start with return row purl and knit stocking stitch for 39 cm (= 104 rows) for front of pillow. Then knit another 104 rows of stocking stitch for back of pillow in the following stripe sequence: * 6 rd base colour of front of pillow, 10 rows colour 27 (black), 10 rows colour 01 (white), repeat another 3 x from *. Now cast of stitches straight.

Arms (2 x):

The arms are started from the top. Cast on 20 st. plus 2 edge stitches, start with 1 return row and knit for 25 cm (= 68 rows), alternating 4 rows in 01 (white) and 4 rows in 27 (black). Pull the stitches together with the working yarn (= bottom end). Close side edges with mattress stitch from right side. For this purpose, place right and left edge of the rectangle together with the right side up. With a blunt sewing needle stitch alternately right and left under the cross thread of the st. next to the edge stitches. Pull the thread after a few cm for the seam to close. The edge stitch and the ½ st. next to it are pulled to the inside, which creates an almost invisible seam.

<u>Legs (2 x):</u>

Knit as arms.

Hair (3 x):

For each hair, cast on 10 ch in colour 27 (black) and close to a rd with 1 sc into the 1.ch and crochet sc in the spiral rds. End the 3 hairs at different heights: 6 cm, 7 cm and 9 cm.

Large eye (colour 01 (white), sc in rd):

Crochet 8 sc in a yarn ring (= 1 rd.)

2. rd.: each st. twisted (= 2 sc in 1. entry point) (= 16 st.)

3. rd.: each 2. st. twisted (= 24 st.)

4. rd.: each 3. st. twisted (= 32 st.)

5. rd.: crochet sc without adding

6. rd.: each 4. st. twisted (= 40 M)

7. rd.: crochet sc without adding

<u>large inner eye (colour 27 (black), sc in rd.):</u>

Cast on 12 ch, close with 1 slip stitch to ring and crochet sc, hereby working respectively 2 sc in each 2. ch (= 18 st.) (= 1. rd.)

2. rd.: each 3. st. twisted (= 24 st.)

small eye (colour 01 (white), sc in rd.):

Crochet as 1. to 5. rd. of large eye.

small inner eye (colour 27 (black), sc in rd.):

Crochet as 1. rd. of large inner eye.

Tooth small (2 x, colour 01 (white), sc in spiral rounds):

Cast on 8 ch and crochet 4 rd. sc, than respectively cast of each 2. and 3. st. together until only 4 st. remain. Pull these 4 stitches together with the working yarn.

Tooth medium (1 x, colour 01 (white), sc in spiral rounds):

Cast on 12 ch and crochet 6 rounds, then finish like small tooth.

Tooth large (1 x, colour 01 (white), sc in spiral rounds):

Work as medium tooth, however, crochet 8 rds of sc. then finish like small tooth.

Finish:

Place the pillow part 39 cm x 39 cm (back on back) together, close the side seams in mattress stitch and insert the pillow. The eyes are sewed onto the front of the pillow. For the mouth, crochet approx. 27 cm chain of ch in colour 27 (black); sew mouth and teeth onto the front side of the pillow (see illustration. Then close bottom seam. If desired, the bottom can also be closed with a zipper. Sew on the arms, legs and hair (see illustration)

Abbreviations:

st. = stitch(es)

R = row(s) sc = single crochet

ch = chain stitch(es)

rd. = round(s)
