## ALASKA PRINT

## Scarf with Bobbles

Difficulty level:
(2) Q

or size needed to achieve given tension

12 mm

Yarn:
Alaska print from Gründl
80 \% Polyacrylic,
20 \% Wool
$100 \mathrm{~g} / 75 \mathrm{~m}$


## Size:

approx. $36 \mathrm{~cm} \times 220 \mathrm{~cm}$
Usage:
approx. 800 g in col. 05 (blue sky multicolour

## Stitch Pattern:

Ribbing: (amount of sts multiple of 2 plus 1 plus 4 selvedge sts)
WS rows: 2 selvedge sts, alt k1, p1 to last 3 sts then k1, 2 selvedge sts
$R S$ rows: 2 selvedge sts, work the sts as they appear ( $k$ the knit sts and $p$ the purl sts), then 2 selvedge sts
Garter st:
RS and WS rows: $k$ all sts between selvedge sts Bobble patt: (amount of sts multiple of 6 plus 3 plus 4 selvedge sts)
Work according to chart. The numbers on the right side show the RS rows and the numbers on the left side of the chart show the WS rows. Work the sts as shown. Work the patt rep 6 times in width between the selvedge sts and end row with the sts after the patt rep. Work rows 1 - 14 in height once, then rows 3-14 twice and then rows 3-8 once. Row 15 is only worked once at the end of the bobble patt according to the instructions
Two stitch selvedge:
k2 at beg of row and at end of row sl2 p-wise wyif
Garter stitch selvedge:
Slip the first st k-wise and k the last st.
Tension:
8 sts and 16 rows to 10 cm meas over garter st using size 12 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.
sts and 12 rows to 10 cm meas over bobble patt using size 12 mm needles or size needed to achieve given tension.

## nstructions:

Cast on 37 sts (including 4 selvedge sts) and beg with WS row work 10 cm (= 13 rows) in ribbing with two stitch selvedge. Then cont in bobble patt with two stitch selvedge. When work meas 37 cm (= 44 rows from the beg of bobble patt, the last row is the 8th row of patt rep), end with row 15 of bobble patt. Then work
in garter st with garter st selvedge. In the first row of garter st dec 5 sts evenly along the row (= k2tog ( 2 selvedge sts) then $3 \times k 2$ tog evenly spaced and k2tog ( 2 selvedge sts at end of row). Work even for 126 cm (= 201 rows) then inc 5 sts evenly spaced in the last garter st row (= M1 (1M re, 1 M li tbl out of 1 st )) (= 37 sts (33 sts plus 4 selvedge sts)). Then work 44 rows in bobble patt with two stitch selvedge on each side. End with patt row 15 . Then work 10 cm ( $=13$ rows) in ribbing with two stich selvedge. Cast off all sts in patt working the two selvedge sts tog (k2tog). Lastly, sew the side edges of the ribbing over the 10 cm tog and then wrap the yarn between the ribbing and bobble patt loosely around the scarf a few times, secure the ends and sew in place.
