ALASKA UNI

Hat and Scarf

Difficulty level:



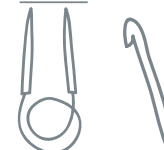
Needles:

Hat:



8 – 9 mm

Scarf:



10 – 12 mm

7 – 8 mm

Yarn:

Alaska uni from Gründl
80 % Polyacrylic,
20 % Wool
100 g / 75 m



3 x 2 x 2 x 1 x

Size:

Hat: Circumference approx. 53 cm – 56 cm **Scarf:** Length approx. 200 cm, width approx. 27 cm

Usage:

Scarf: Approx. 200 g each in col. 04 (pistachio), col. 07 (cream) and col. 10 (gold), approx. 100 g in col. 11 (medium brown)

Hat: Approx. 100 g in col. 04 (pistachio) and small amounts left over from scarf in col. 07 (= approx. 60 g in col. cream) and col. 11 (= approx. 20 g in col. medium brown)

For both designs together:
approx. 300 g in col. 04 (pistachio), approx. 200 g each in col. 07 (cream) and col. 10 (gold), approx. 100 g in col. 11 (medium brown)

Tension:

Garter Stitch: k all sts in all RS and WS rows.

Selvedge stitches: at beg of row: sl 1 k-wise; at end of row k 1.

Colour Repeat Scarf:

See chart. Repeat the pattern (= 160 rows) in height a total of 2 times.

Colour Repeat Hat:

Cast on row and first row in col. cream, then 2 rows in col. brown, 2 rows in col. cream, 2 rows in col. pistachio, 2 rows in col. cream, then cont. to end in col. pistachio.

Tension:

Hat: 11 sts and 22 rows measured to 10 cm over garter stitch using 9,0 – 10,0mm needles.

Scarf: 8 sts and 16 rows measured to 10 cm over garter stitch using 10,0 – 12,0mm needles.

Instructions:

Hat:

The hat is worked in rows. Using col. cream cast on 44 sts (42 sts plus 2 selvedge sts) and work in garter st in the given col. sequence for 13,5cm (29 rows). 1st row is a WS row.

Row 30 (RS): selvedge stitch, * k5, k2tog, rep from * to end. (= 38 sts)

Rows 31–33 and all foll rows without decreases: k all sts between selvedge sts.

Row 34: selvedge stitch, * k4, k2tog, rep from * to end. (= 32 sts)

Row 38: selvedge stitch, * k53 k2tog, rep from * to end. (= 26 sts)

Row 40: selvedge stitch, * k2, k2tog, rep from * to end. (= 20 sts)

Row 42: K2tog to end. (= 10 sts)

Break yarn and thread through these last 10 sts twice and pull tog tightly. Sew back seam as flat as possible. Make pompon with approx. 9cm circumference in col. cream and attach to top of hat.

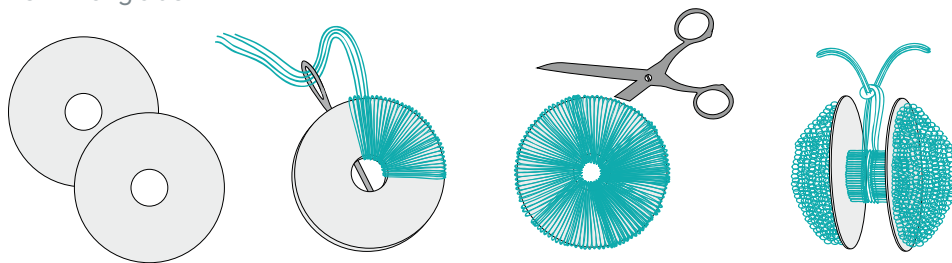
Instructions for making a pompon can be found here:

Scarf:

Using col. pistachio cast on 22 sts (20 sts plus 2 selvedge sts) and beg with a WS row work in garter stitch according to colour sequence in chart. When work meas. 200 cm (= 320 rows) cast off all sts loosely in col. cream. Then work the vertical stripes loosely according to the chart using slip stitches placing the crochet hook in every 2nd row under the garter stitch. The working thread comes from below and is worked from bottom to the top of the scarf. Knot fringes into the ends of the scarf. For each bundle of fringes cut 4 pieces of yarn each approx. 40 cm long and fold in half. Knot these into the end of the scarf matching the colours to the crocheted vertical stripes as shown in picture.
