### Hat and Scarf

#### Needles:

9 – 10 mm

Alaska from Gründl  
80 % Acrylic,  
20 % Wool  
100 g / 75 m

#### Size:

Hat: Circumference approx.  
54 cm – 57 cm

Scarf: 200 cm x 26 cm

Usage: (Hat and Scarf as set)  
approx. 500 g col. 09 (medium  
grey = MC) und approx. 100 g  
col. 13 (eggshell = CC)

Hat with Pom-Pom: approx. 70 g  
col. 09 und approx. 60 g col. 13

Scarf: approx. 400 g col. 09 und  
approx. 20 g col. 13

#### Pattern:

##### Double Moss Stitch:

Row 1 (WS): K1 tbl (selvedge st) \* K 1, P 1, rep from  
\* to last st then sl 1 k-wise wyif (selvedge st).

Row 2 (RS): K1 tbl (selvedge st) \* P 1, K 1, rep from  
\* to last st then sl 1 k-wise wyif (selvedge st)..

Row 3 (WS): K1 tbl (selvedge st) \* P 1, K 1, rep from  
\* to last st then sl 1 k-wise wyif (selvedge st)..

Row 4 (WS): K1 tbl (selvedge st) \* K 1, P 1, rep from  
\* to last st then sl 1 k-wise wyif (selvedge st)..

Rep rows 1–4 cont for pattern.

##### Tension:

Hat: 11 sts and 15 rows to 10 cm meas over Dou-  
ble Moss Stitch using needle size 9 mm or size  
needed to achieve given tension.

Scarf: 10 sts and 12 rows to 10 cm meas over  
Double Moss Stitch using needle size 10 mm or  
size needed to achieve given tension.

##### Colour Rep:

Hat: \* 2 rows MC, 2 rows CC. Rep from \* 3 times  
total, ending the Hat with MC. Make Pom-pom  
in CC.

Scarf: 6 rows MC, \* 2 rows CC, 2 rows MC, rep  
from \* two times total, then 2 rows CC. Then  
212 rows (approx. 176 cm) in MC and end with \* 2  
rows CC, 2 rows MC, rep from \* twice, then end  
with 4 rows and cast off in MC.

##### Instructions:

##### Hat:

The Hat is worked in rows.

Cast on 46 sts (44 + 2 selvedge sts) using MC  
and size 9 mm needles. Beg with a WS row work  
straight for 16,5 cm in double moss st patt and  
col rep.

Shape Top: (Dec are made in RS rows. Cont patt  
as established in other rows).

Row 26 (RS): Selvedge st, 1 st in patt, P3tog, \* 9  
sts in patt, P3tog, rep from \* 3 times, end with 4  
sts in patt, selvedge st. = 38 sts

Row 28: Selvedge st, 3 st in patt, P3tog, 7 sts in  
patt, \* P3tog, \* 7 sts in patt, rep from \* twice,  
end with selvedge st. = 30 sts

Row 30: Selvedge st, P3 tog, \* 5 sts in patt, P3tog, rep from \* 3 times, end with 1 st in patt, selvedge st. = 22 sts.

Row 32: Selvedge st, 2 sts in patt, P3tog, \* 3 sts in patt, P3tog, rep from \* twice, end with 3 sts in patt, P2tog (1 st in patt and selvedge st). = 15 sts.

Row 33 (WS): P 2 tog to end = 8 sts.

Break yarn and thread through remaining sts twice and pull closed. Join back seam. Using CC make 1 pom-pom with 9cm diameter and sew to top of hat. Weave in ends.

#### Scarf:

Cast on 26 sts (24 + 2 selvedge sts) using MC and size 10 mm needles. Beg with a WS row work straight in double moss st patt and col rep. to a finished length of 200 cm (= 244 rows). Cast off in patt.
